Control Commission

1. Definition

1.1 The Control Commission is made up of five members, including the Chair, elected by the Congress. These members will not be members of the Presidium.

2. Tasks.

2.1. The Control Commission has to control the execution of the decisions of the statutory bodies and the Secretary General.

2.2. The Control Commission is to be consulted on financial matters and agreements.

3.3. The Control Commission will have any kind of task set by the Regulatory texts of ECOSY.

4. Members.

4.1. The members of the Control Commission have to be members of a full member organisation of ECOSY.

4.2. Should a member of the Control Commission cease to belong to a full member organisation during his/her time of office, or if a member of the Control Commission resigns, the Bureau elects a new member, following a proposal of the Presidium.

5. The Control Commission meets at least once a year.

6. Between the Congresses the Control Commission is the only body which can interpret the Statutes.
