## **Control Commission**

- 1. Definition
- 1.1 The Control Commission is made up of five members, including the Chair, elected by the Congress. These members will not be members of the Presidium.
- 2. Tasks.
- 2.1. The Control Commission has to control the execution of the decisions of the statutory bodies and the Secretary General.
- 2.2. The Control Commission is to be consulted on financial matters and agreements.
- 3.3. The Control Commission will have any kind of task set by the Regulatory texts of ECOSY.
- 4. Members.
- 4.1. The members of the Control Commission have to be members of a full member organisation of ECOSY.
- 4.2. Should a member of the Control Commission cease to belong to a full member organisation during his/her time of office, or if a member of the Control Commission resigns, the Bureau elects a new member, following a proposal of the Presidium.
- 5. The Control Commission meets at least once a year.
- 6. Between the Congresses the Control Commission is the only body which can interpret the Statutes.
