
Methodology




Right Direction vs. Wrong Track




Do you feel things in the country are generally going in the right direction, or do you think things are seriously off on the wrong track?




Bush Job Approval




Do you approve or disapprove of the way George W. Bush is handling his job as President?

Favorability: Public Figures






The Mood - Local vs. National

Most Important Issue – Local vs. National




And what is the most important issue facing your area today? (open-end)

And what is the most important issue facing the U.S. today? (open-end)



Congressional Job Approval




Your Member / U.S. Congress: Priorities



Which one of the following issues do you think should be top priority for [Split Sample A: your member of Congress / Split Sample B: the U.S. Congress] to address?





Interest in Congressional Elections




As you may know, there will be elections for U.S. Congress this fall, November 2006. How much interest do you have in the upcoming elections for U.S. Congress?






Congressional Candidate Choice




When you think about how you might vote in the next election for U.S. Congress, which of the following is most likely to affect your candidate choice?

Who will control Congress?



2008 Presidential Election




Generic Presidential Ballot

John McCain vs. Hillary Clinton






Impact of the Middle East Conflict on the U.S.
