### MEMBERSHIP

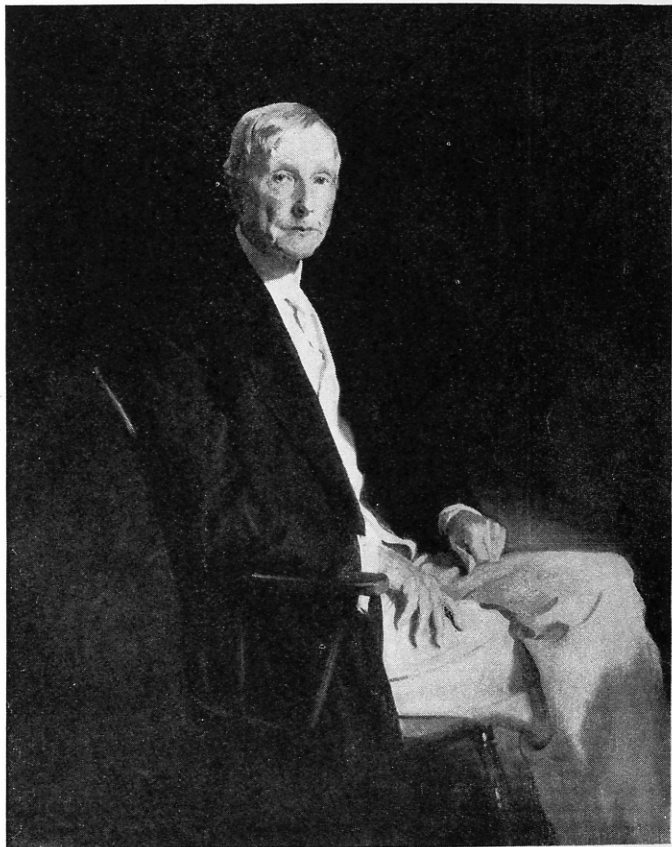

### HOURS OF ADMISSION

The Museum is open to the public *free* on week days from 9 a. m. to 5 p. m. On Sundays from 2 to 6 p. m. On holidays from 2 to 5 p. m. It is also open frequently in the evenings for the display of special exhibitions and for lectures.

The pictures were invited from the important 1918 exhibitions in the East, supplemented by loans from private collections and from the studios of artists. It is a satisfaction to number among them many paintings honored with important awards.

The works for this exhibition have been selected, as far as possible, without partiality or prejudice. It is important that the newer forces and tendencies, particularly those which concern themselves devotedly and sincerely with the expression of problems and motives of the present day, should be shown if one is to get a comprehensive idea of the accomplishment of our American painters.

The Trustees gratefully acknowledge their indebtedness to the artists and owners who have contributed works for this exhibition and to those who have otherwise given of their advice and co-operation in making it a success.

Artists have graciously contributed paintings for this exhibit with the hope of finding a permanent home for them in Detroit. Most of the works are for sale at studio prices. Prices and other information regarding works in the exhibit may be had at the office of the Director.

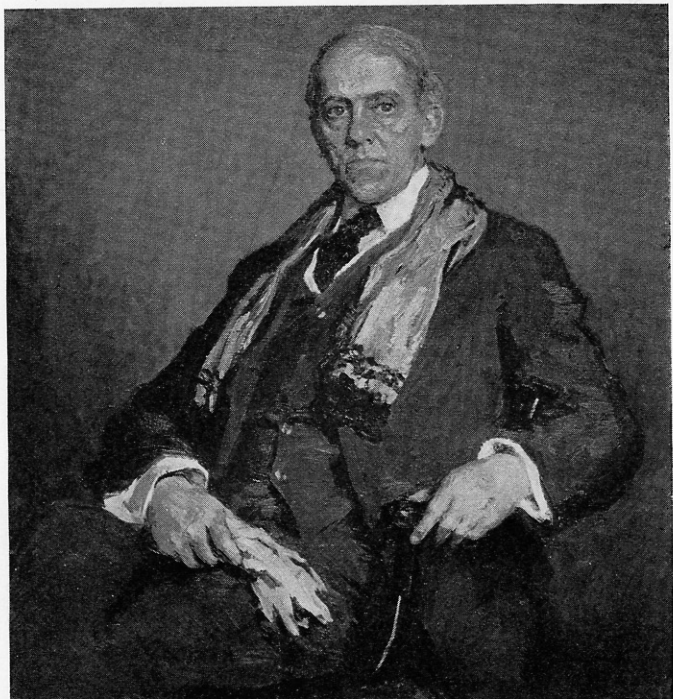

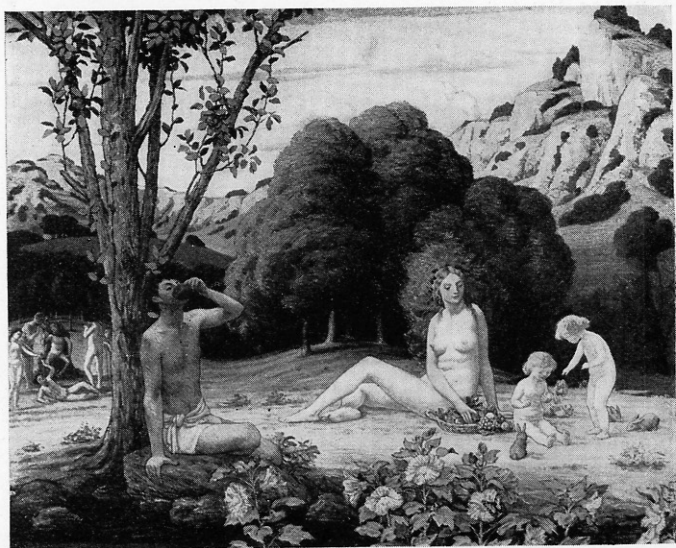

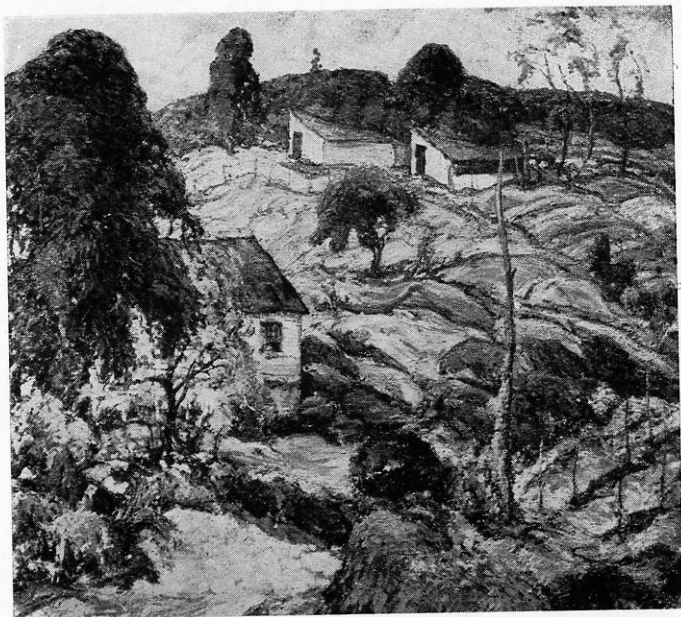
