
Business Segment Revenue


Ocean Baroness

- > Solution = Call Oceaneering










Riser Repair

- Designed, built & tested specialized repair tool.
- Mobilized tool & second ROV to job site offshore Malaysia
- 19 days after incident occurred, riser and drill string recovered








Gulf of Mexico SPAR

- Problem: Riser connector failure
- Solution: Custom ROV tooling and subsea services
- Challenge: Repair to be done while drilling and production operations continued
- Solution: Call Oceaneering

- > H.L. Hunley Sank in 1864
- Integrity of the Submarine after 135+ years in doubt
- Recovery of the Hunley in the same position as it rested on the sea floor required



- > Titanic Sank 1912
- Depth ~ 12,500 ft.
- Salvage Site Expeditions in 1998, 2000 and 2005
- Live video feed and artifact recovery

M/V Lucona

- 1977 M/V Lucona allegedly loaded with a 'Uranium Processing Mill'
- Lucona disappeared in ArabianSea @ 14,800 fsw
- Six of 12 people on board perished
- Cargo owner filed an \$18M insurance claim





M/V Lucona - Search

Oceaneering locatedthe wreckage andmapped the debris field





M/V Lucona - Identification

 Obtained absolute evidence supporting a massive internal explosion – no evidence of external device









M/V Lucona – Investigation Results

- Most expensive trial in Austrian history
- > Evidence for deliberate sabotage was clear and overwhelming
- Cargo owner was convicted of fraud and murder
- ➤ No insurance claim paid
