INTRODUCTION

At its inception, 100 artists were invited to join the league based on their artistic skills and accomplishments; forty-seven artists became founding members. There are five honorary members whose work is exemplary and who are models for the caliber of individual worthy of the label, artist.

The mission of the Art League of Rhode Island to provide opportunities to exhibit and to promote the work of its professional artist members is specifically addressed by the annual Members' Exhibition. Commitment, attitude, growth, and determination are characteristics of the artist. While each artist's work is distinct, these expressions collectively promote communication between artists and the public, and encourage education in the arts for all.

Artist members of the Art League of Rhode Island were invited to submit two slides of works from which a jury of selection chose one that would best integrate the exhibition, to be shown in the International Scholar-Athlete Hall of Fame and Museum. These pieces have been photographed and collected in this catalog to accompany the exhibition, and is offered by the Art League of Rhode Island in its effort to elevate the status of art in our culture and share the work of its members.

Welcome to the International Scholar-Athlete Hall of Fame and the Art League of Rhode Island's 3rd Annual Members' Exhibit.



IN MEMORIAM. Providence, Rhode Island native and Art League of Rhode Island founding member David Aldrich was a graduate of Brown University and the Columbia School of Architecture. He was a practicing architect for many years, but always retained his interest in painting, studying watercolor at the O'Hara School, the Positano Workshop and the Rhode Island School of Design.

Aldrich's paintings, predominantly landscapes and cityscapes, depict particular places even though they are not painted with literal realism, but with freedom and spontaneity in an attempt to capture the essence of the scene. As one critic wrote: "His view is always fresh and unhackneyed, his brush is deft, swift strokes and colors translucent and unmuddied- the paper often does the majority of the work... a sort of artistic shorthand that makes watercolor exciting."

A life member of the Providence Art Club and The Rhode Island Watercolor Society, Aldrich has had numerous one-man exhibitions. Group shows include those at the Rhode Island School of Design Museum, De Cordova Museum, Virginia Lynch Gallery, Wheeler Gallery and others.

ALRI: PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE

we celebrate our 3rd year, and take stock in our accomplishments to date, the Art League of Rhode Island continues to focus on exhibition, education, and expansion. The Founding Members' Exhibit, "The Art/The Artist," held at the Bristol Art Museum, Bristol, R.I., in March 2001, was reviewed in Art New England. Elizabeth E. Neville wrote, "It is rare to view so many skillfully handled media in a group exhibition... all handled masterfully." The Virginia Lynch Gallery, in Tiverton, R.I., nationally recognized for its support of contemporary art, hosted the Second Annual Members' Exhibit, in March 2002. With the third exhibition in April 2003, at the International Scholar-Athlete Hall of Fame and Museum, ALRI produced its first catalog.

"To encourage and foster artistic growth among Rhode Island artists," the Art League of Rhode Island sponsors educational programs in the form of workshops, lectures, and seminars. Rhode Island notables Gretchen Dow Simpson, Robin Wiseman, Thomas Sgouros, and Evelyn Rhodes are but a few who have highlighted the program roster. In March 2003 a workshop series was held entitled "Artists in the Round" which highlighted Rhode Island artists Tom Deininger-oil, Nancy Gaucher-Thomas-watercolor, and Jeanne Tangney-pastel, each approaching identical subject matter simultaneously through their respective medium.

Present endeavors contribute to building on a proud foundation. The future of ALRI is in its membership. The promising trajectory begun by the founding and honorary members continues. Applications for membership were submitted by thirty-three artists in 2001, and thirty-six in 2002. Ten slides accompanied each application which were judged by a jury of four ALRI artist members and one honorary member who rated the work based on standards of excellence. From these juries eight and ten members respectively achieved membership. ALRI exists to provide artists the recognition of peers and encourages new and former applicants whose work will continue to define the Art League of Rhode Island.
