Some GSWA publications are available only on microfiche. The formats in which particular publications are available are listed throughout this catalogue.

## **Annual Reports**

The Annual Reports of the Geological Survey of Western Australia, incorporated within the Mines Department Annual Reports, were produced between 1897 and 1980. Exceptions to this are the Geological Survey Annual Reports for 1954, 1955, 1956, and 1957 which were published in the Bulletin series: nos 109, 112, 113, and 114 respectively

The Annual Report conventionally contained a review of Geological Survey activities for the previous year, those projected for the year of publication, staff movements, divisional operations, and a number of technical papers on matters of geological significance.

As of 1981, the practice of publishing a separate Annual Report for the Geological Survey (within the Mines Department Annual Report) was discontinued. Administrative details and annual programs continue to be included in the Mines Department Annual Reports, and are described in more detail in the annual 'Summary of the progress of the Geological Survey' which is published in the Record series (commencing in 1982). Geoscientific papers of the type that were included in the Annual Reports prior to 1981 were subsequently published in the Report series as 'Professional Papers' (commencing with Professional Papers for 1982) until 1994, when they, too, were discontinued.

Some Geological Survey Annual Reports have not been available in book form for several years, and stocks of others are very low. However, all can be viewed in the Geological Survey Library in both book and microfiche form.

In 1994 the Geological Survey resurrected its annual report — called Geological Survey of Western Australia Annual Review. Copies are available free of charge.
