






## Welcome

The new Parramatta Transport Interchange provides improved transport services and facilities for the growing population of Western Sydney.


Work for the Interchange commenced in late 2003 and involved:

- An upgrade of Parramatta Station including platform and concourse refurbishment and extensions, improved weather protection, amenities, ticket facilities and security features.
- Construction of a new bus interchange in Argyle Street with passenger amenities including large passenger information displays, lighting, weather protection and comfortable seating and new bus turnback and layover facilities.

Initially scheduled for completion at the end of 2006, the Parramatta Transport Interchange has been completed 10 months ahead of schedule. The new Parramatta Transport Interchange links Parramatta Station, one of the busiest on the CityRail Network with the Western Sydney Transitway network, local buses, taxis, coaches and private vehicle kiss and ride. The proximity of the new bus interchange to the station and the construction of new underground pedestrian connections makes accessing transport services easier and safer for pedestrians. The interchange also supports Parramatta's development as Sydney's second major employment and commercial centre and is integrated with other developments in the Parramatta CBD.

Train tickets are available for purchase in the Eastern and Western concourses of Parramatta Station.

## Station Features

**Station Access** Escalator, lift and stair access is available from all platforms to the western concourse of the station and from the western concourse up to street level at Darcy Street and the northern side of the Argyle Street bus interchange. A new pedestrian underpass provides access from the western concourse directly through to the southern side of the bus interchange and Westfield.

Lift and stair or escalator access is available from all platforms to the eastern concourse of the station. Stair and lift access is available from the eastern concourse of the station up to street level at Station Street and the northern side of the Argyle Street interchange.

**Ticket Counters** are provided in the eastern and western concourse.

**Ticket Machines** are provided in the eastern and western concourse.

**Toilets** are located in the western concourse of the station and on platform 4.

**Station Manager's Office** is located in the western concourse of the station.

**Security Features** The new station walls and canopies are made primarily of glass providing improved line-of-site security through the station to the Argyle Street bus interchange and Darcy Street. Passengers are reminded to use the Nightsafe area on each platform when travelling after 7pm.

**New Passenger Information Systems** are provided throughout the Station.

### Taxi, Coach & Private Vehicle Information

**Taxis** The taxi rank for Parramatta Transport Interchange is located on the southern side of Fitzwilliam Street. See the map on page 4 for more information.

**Coaches** A new coach rank is located on the northern side of Fitzwilliam Street, adjacent to the Fitzwilliam to Argyle Street pedestrian corridor. See the map on page 4 for more information.

#### Private Vehicles - New arrangements

**Bus Only Areas** The Argyle Street bus interchange, the eastern turnback facility on Station Street, the western turnback facility at the corner of Argyle and Pitt Streets and Argyle Street eastbound between Pitt and Church Streets are now BUS & AUTHORISED VEHICLE ONLY zones. Private vehicles are reminded that these restrictions are enforceable.

**Hassall and Station Street intersection** Private vehicles exiting Hassall Street to Station Street may turn left only.

Fitzwilliam Street Fitzwilliam Street is now open to two-way traffic.

**Kiss and ride** A new kiss and ride facility is available for private vehicles on the northern side of Fitzwilliam Street adjacent to the coach rank and the Fitzwilliam to Argyle Street pedestrian corridor. See the map on page 4 for more information.

**New pedestrian crossings** New pedestrian crossings are in place throughout the Parramatta transport precinct. Drivers are advised to exercise caution when driving through the area.

# Argyle Street Bus Interchange

The new bus interchange is located on Argyle Street between Church Street and Valentine Square and consolidates all bus services to one location directly adjacent to Parramatta Station.

The interchange is accessible to buses and authorised vehicles only. Private vehicles are prohibited from entering the interchange.

Pedestrian access to the bus interchange is available at street level from Fitzwilliam Street, Valentine Square and Church Street and from subway level from Parramatta Station, Westfield and Darcy Street. The interchange features large passenger information displays, high level lighting, weather protection canopies and comfortable seating.








### The New Interchange




### The design of the new Parramatta Transport Interchange:

- Integrates transport modes with retail and entertainment facilities, with pedestrian pathways providing connectivity.
- Provides long sight lines and improved security within and across the interchange through the extensive use of glazing on walls and canopies.
- Includes prominent signage, integrated throughout the interchange and wider concourses and footpaths, to improve accessibility and comply with Australian Standards.
- Provides a dedicated bus interchange to consolidate services and make interchanging between bus services easier and safer for commuters.
- Incorporates public art walls reflecting elements of transport, landscape and heritage, providing for an improved urban amenity and sense of place.
- Integrates heritage elements from the existing Station with the new Interchange buildings and features.



Parramatta Railway Station is one of the oldest continually operating railway stations in NSW. It's buildings and infrastructure span the history of the NSW rail network from 1859 to present. The site is associated with the traditional lands of the Burramatta people and the original colonial estate of Dr D'Arcy Wentworth. Transport to and from Parramatta has played a significant role in the development and growth of Sydney:



#### Timeline of Public Transport in Parramatta

- 1797 New road established between Port Jackson and Parramatta along present day alignment of Parramatta Road.
- 1823 First regular stage coach service from Sydney to Parramatta township.
- 1831 First steamer ferry service along Parramatta River.
- 1855 First steam engine train runs from Sydney Central Station to Parramatta Junction at Dog Trap Road (James Ruse Drive) Stage coach service ceases – unable to compete with more efficient train and ferry.
- 1859 Railway extended to Parramatta township under direction of Engineer in Chief, John Whitton, marking a new era of rail development in NSW.

- 1859 Platform 4 station building constructed.
- 1885 Platform 2/3 station building and signal box built.
- 1902 Steam tramway opened from Parramatta (along Argyle Street) to Baulkham Hills and later to Castle Hill, operating for 25 years.
- 1924 Platform 4 parcels building constructed.
- 1929 Electric trains commence running to Parramatta.
- 1940s Country Link building on Darcy Street built, reflecting growth and importance of Parramatta town centre.
- 1985 Western Concourse upgraded to cater for increasing passenger demand.
- 1996 Eastern Concourse constructed.
- 2006 Parramatta Transport Interchange opened to the public
