The National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) is an independent federal agency created by Congress in 1965. NEH is the single largest funder of humanities programs in the United States.

WE URGE CONGRESS TO SUPPORT FUNDING OF \$156 MILLION FOR FY 2007 FOR THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE HUMANITIES, AN INCREASE OF \$15 MILLION ABOVE THE FY 2006 APPROPRIATION AND THE PRESIDENT'S REQUEST.

ADDITIONAL FUNDING WILL STRENGTHEN NEH'S ABILITY TO SUPPORT HIGH-QUALITY HUMANITIES PROJECTS THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES. A proportional increase for all grant programs could help offset the recent decline in funding for NEH core programs, and provide a modest increase to extend the reach of the NEH We the People initiative:

- \$1.7 million for the Research Division to support basic research and original scholarship
- \$1.6 million for the Education Division to strengthen teaching and learning in the humanities in our nation's schools, colleges, and universities
- \$1.3 million for Challenge Grants to strengthen the institutional base of the humanities
- \$2.5 million for the Preservation & Access Division to preserve and make accessible significant historical, cultural and intellectual resources
- \$1.7 million for the Public Programs Division to support humanities projects in media (film, television, radio), discussion series, and exhibits at museums, historical societies, libraries and archives
- \$4.2 million for the Federal/State Partnership to support the work of the state humanities councils
- \$2.0 million for the NEH We the People initiative to promote the study and understanding of American history and culture

FUNDING HISTORY

The National Endowment for the Humanities is funded under the **Interior** appropriations bill. NEH is funded at \$140.949 million in FY 2006. For the second year in a row, the Administration has requested flat funding for the NEH. In addition, the President's FY 2007 budget proposal would cut funding for NEH grant programs by \$1.32 million to offset administrative salary and overhead cost increases. The collective effect of flat budgets and rescissions means that each NEH core program division has lost approximately 3% of its funding since FY 2002.

BACKGROUND

NEH grants are awarded on a competitive, peer-review basis to organizations, institutions and individuals throughout the country. Many grants provide significant leveraging of nonfederal giving through matching requirements. Awards are made to nonprofit cultural institutions, such as **colleges**, **universities**, **museums**, **archives**, **libraries**, **public television**, and **radio stations**; to **state humanities councils**; and to individual **scholars**. NEH extends its reach through annual operating grants to its partner institutions, the 56 state humanities councils, located in every state and U.S. territory.

President Bush launched the NEH We the People initiative in 2002 to promote the study and teaching of American history and culture; to preserve the nation's historic documents; and to disseminate knowledge of American history and culture through exhibitions, public programs, and partnerships with the state humanities councils.
