

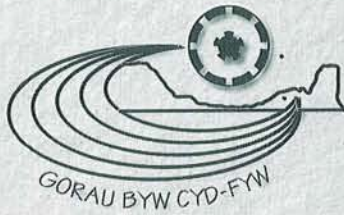

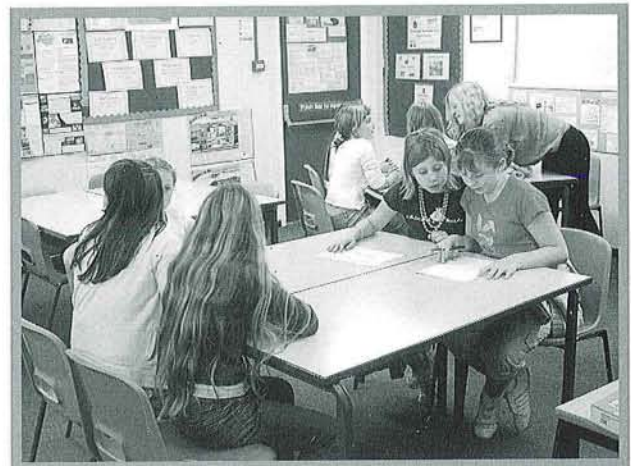

This is a happy school - my child enjoys going to school.

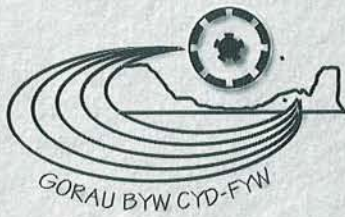

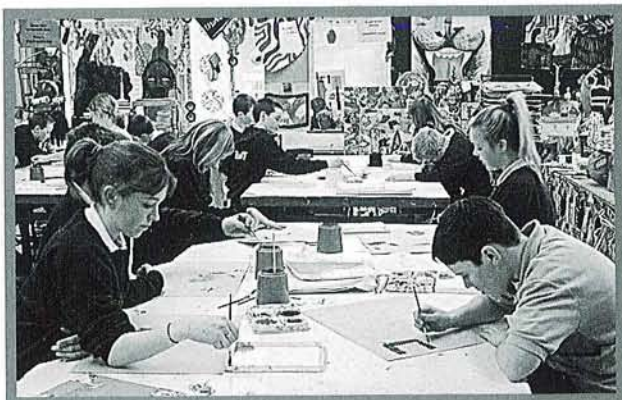
Pastoral Care

The underlying aim of the pastoral care system is to ensure that every individual receives the attention that is necessary for his/her well being and happiness while at school.

The Form Tutor is in daily contact with the children in his/her form and is therefore a key person in this process. We believe it to be important that every child has someone in school in whom he/she can trust and with whom any school-related matters or personal problems can be discussed. As part of the pastoral care and the Progress File system each pupil has specific and regular personal discussion time with the Form Tutor. This makes it possible to discuss any problems or difficulties which may arise and which are causing concern to the pupil.

The work of the Form Tutor is reinforced by the Head of Year, Assistant Headteachers and Headteacher.

The school has a specific pastoral curriculum and time is set aside each week for this. It provides an opportunity to discuss all topics related to the pupils' personal lives, including relationships with others, health education, careers, study skills and communication. Also an

important and natural part of these lessons is sex education.

Specific Aims of Sex Education:

- ▶ To introduce and discuss matters connected with sex in a sensitive and caring manner.
- ▶ To give the pupils an opportunity to receive factual information about their bodies and processes connected with sex, such as puberty, contraception, abortion, Aids and sexually transmitted diseases.
- ▶ To do this within the context of caring and loving relationships, of personal responsibility and of respect for oneself and others.

Some Specific Sex Education Topics:

- Starting my life
- Conception, growth and birth of a baby
- Physical changes
- Forming relationships
- Peer pressure
- Caring for friends and lovers
- AIDS
- Contraception
- Cancer – breast, cervical and testicular
- Sexually transmitted diseases
- Being a parent

Y Defnydd a Wneir o'r Gymraeg

Cymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol hon ac anogir a chynorthwyr yr holl ddisgyblion i'w meistrolï a'i defnyddio ar bob achlysur.

Mae'r Gymraeg yn bwnc craidd yn yr ysgol ac felly yn rhan o gwricwlwm pob disgybl.

Yn ogystal, defnyddir y Gymraeg fel cyfrwng dysgu yn helaeth iawn. Dysgir yr holl destunau, ac eithrio Saesneg a Gwyddoniaeth trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg

yn unig. Dysgir Gwyddoniaeth trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg yn unig ym mlynnyddoedd 7 – 9 ac anogir y disgyblion i ddilyn cwrs Gwyddoniaeth Blynnyddoedd 10 – 11 yn y Gymraeg yn ogystal. Mae cyfle i ddilyn y cwrs hwn trwy gyfrwng y Saesneg pe dymunir hynny. Felly cynigir cyrsiau Gwyddoniaeth Blwyddyn 10 – 11 yn y ddwy iaith. Ar hyn o bryd, ar gyfer Safon 'A' cynigir pynciau Gwyddonol ac Economeg drwy gyfrwng y Saesneg yn unig.

The Curriculum

A Summary of the School's Curriculum Aims

Our main aim is to provide a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum to every pupil in the school by:

- meeting all the statutory requirements of the National Curriculum
- responding to the choices of our pupils and ensuring that a wide range of relevant learning paths are available through the medium of Welsh 11-18
- developing the Basic and Key Skills of all our pupils which include Literacy, Numeracy, Information Technology, and Communication skills
- developing in each individual positive attitudes which will enable him/her to adapt flexibly to new ideas and situations
- developing the ability of pupils to work independently as well as members of a team to solve problems and to decide on specific ways of accomplishing tasks
- helping each individual to become sensitive to the needs of others and to become caring and responsible citizens
- motivating each individual to reach his/her full potential, using the Progress File to actively involve pupils in the process of self-evaluation and action planning to make further progress
- promoting equal opportunities and inclusion and the principle of respecting every individual within the school unit as well as in the wider community, thus allowing our young people to mature into active citizens
- promoting Welshness and the Cwricwlwm Cymreig and fostering an awareness of the nation's heritage and culture, as well as an understanding of, and a respect towards, other cultures.
- promoting a world-wide awareness of environmental and sustainability issues
- promoting an awareness of healthy living and healthy eating
- developing an understanding of the requirements of the world of work and providing pupils with opportunities to gain real life experiences of the work place and vocational courses; in addition by ensuring that every pupil receives high quality careers advice and guidance.

Use of Welsh

The school's official language is Welsh and all pupils are encouraged and helped to master the language and to use it at all times.

Welsh is a core subject at the school and features therefore in each child's curriculum.

Welsh is also used substantially as a teaching medium. All subjects, excluding English and Science, are taught solely through the medium of Welsh.

Science is also taught exclusively through the medium of Welsh during Years 7 – 9 and pupils are encouraged to pursue their Science courses in Years 10 and 11 through the medium of Welsh. The opportunity to follow this course through the medium of English is available if so desired. Therefore Year 10 and 11 Science courses are offered in both languages. At present, 'A' level courses in the Science subjects and Economics are taught through the medium of English only.

un neu fwy o gyflogwyr yn y gymuned leol. Cyfnod yw hwn i'r disgyblion gael blas ar fyd gwaith tra'n gweithio ochr yn ochr â gweithwyr profiadol. Bydd disgyblion y 6ed Dosbarth yn gwneud wythnos o brofiad gwaith ar ddiwedd Blwyddyn 12. Mae disgyblion Blwyddyn 11 a Blwyddyn 13 yn cael y cyfle i fod yn rhan o ffug-gyfweliadau a gynhelir gan gyflogwyr lleol.

Careers Advice and Guidance

Considerable attention is given to Careers Education and the careful and thorough counselling of pupils. Regular liaison with the school Careers Officer is invited and encouraged. A World of Work programme of work related activities has been developed for Years 7-13 which includes Industry, Business and Enterprise days.

All Year 10 pupils spend a week out of school on **WORK EXPERIENCE** with one or more employers within the local community. This is an opportunity for the pupils to experience the world of work and to work alongside experienced workers. The 6th Form pupils spend a week on work experience at the end of Year 12. Pupils in Years 11 and 13 have the opportunity to take part in mock interviews held by local employers.

Addysg Anghenion Arbennig

Anghenion Addysgol Arbennig (AAA) – yw'r anghenion addysgol sydd gan ddisgyblion oherwydd anawsterau cyfathrebu a rhyngweithio, gwybyddiaeth a dysgu, ymddygiad, datblygiad emosiynol a chymdeithasol neu anghenion synhwyraidd a/neu gorfforol, sy'n gwneud y ddarpariaeth addysgol arferol yn anaddas i'w gofynion.

Nôd yr ysgol yw sicrhau gwerth cyfartal i bob disgybl. I gyflawni hyn y mae'r ysgol yn derbyn y dylai pob unigolyn gael y cyfle i gyfranogi o gwricwlwm eang, cytbwys a gwahaniaethol beth bynnag yw'r anghenion addysgol arbennig ac i ddatblygu hyd eithaf ei allu o fewn y cwricwlwm hwn. I gyflawni hyn bydd yr ysgol yn –

- darparu cymaint o gymorth dysgu ag sy'n bosib;
- cynnal dulliau asesu ar draws y cwricwlwm sy'n cydnabod gwendidau a chryfderau disgyblion ag anghenion addysgol arbennig;
- cadw'r dosbarthiadau mor fach ag sy'n bosib o flwyddyn 9 ymlaen pan ddefnyddir peth setio sy'n galluogi creu grwpiau llai yn y pynciau craidd ar gyfer disgyblion ag anawsterau dysgu;

Gwaith Cartref

Mae gan yr ysgol *Bolisi Gwaith Cartref* clir. Disgwylir i bob disgybl gyflawni Gwaith Cartref yn brydlon, yn daclus ac i'r safon uchaf posibl. Bydd y gwaith fel arfer yn cymryd tua ugain munud y pwnc a rhoddir digon o amser i'w gyflwyno.

Mae gan bob disgybl '*Llyfr Cyswllt*' a disgwylir i bob unigolyn gofnodi pob tasg gwaith cartref ynddo. Mae'r '*Llyfr Cyswllt*' yn gymorth i gadw trefn ar dasgau ac i sicrhau nad yw gwaith yn pentyrru. Gofynnwn i rieni archwilio a llofnodi'r Llyfr Cyswllt ar ddiwedd pob wythnos fel bod modd i'r ysgol a'r cartref gadw golwg ar y gwaith sy'n cael ei gyflawni.

Organisation of Teaching

At present lessons are organised in 1 hour periods and we work to a fortnightly timetable of 50 lessons. Pupils in Years 7 and 8 are taught in mixed ability groups. On average there are about 25 pupils in each teaching group.

The methodology of teaching employed at the school is pupil centred and activity based. Pupils are encouraged to work together, discuss viewpoints, solve problems, agree on strategies and generally make decisions for themselves. This method of teaching gives each pupil the opportunity to play an active role in his/her learning.

Arrangements for Special Educational Needs

Special Education Needs (SEN) – are a pupil's educational needs which arise from difficulties with communication and interaction, cognition and learning behaviour, emotional and social development, or sensory and/or physical difficulties which make the usual educational provision unsuitable for his/her needs.

The school's objective is to ensure equal opportunities for all pupils. The school therefore accepts that all pupils, whatever their needs, should be given an opportunity to participate in a broad, balanced and differentiating curriculum within which they may develop to the best of their ability. To accomplish this, the school will –

- integrate pupils to ensure mixed ability classes in Years 7 and 8. However, there is a 'Special Teaching Facility' at the school for children with specific learning difficulties;
- expect every teacher to be an SEN teacher;
- accept that within a mixed ability class there will be special needs at each end of the ability range;
- provide as much supportive teaching as possible
- maintain assessment methods across the curriculum which recognise SEN pupils' strengths and weaknesses;
- keep classes as small as possible from Year 9 onwards where setting will be used in order to create smaller groups in the core subjects for children with learning difficulties;
- meticulous consultation and discussion with the primary schools in readiness for the provision in Yr 7;
- utilise all external agencies available for further assistance.
- The school has an SEN co-ordinator who can be contacted to discuss specific concerns.

Homework

The school has a clear Homework Policy. It is expected that each pupil will complete homework tasks promptly, neatly and to the highest possible standard. The work should take about twenty minutes per subject and ample time is allowed for its submission.

Every pupil has a 'Llyfr Cyswllt' (Home-School Contact Book) in which we expect all homework tasks to be recorded. This system helps to organise work and to ensure that tasks do not mount up unduly. We ask parents to check and sign the Llyfr Cyswllt at the end of each week so that both school and home can monitor the work completed.

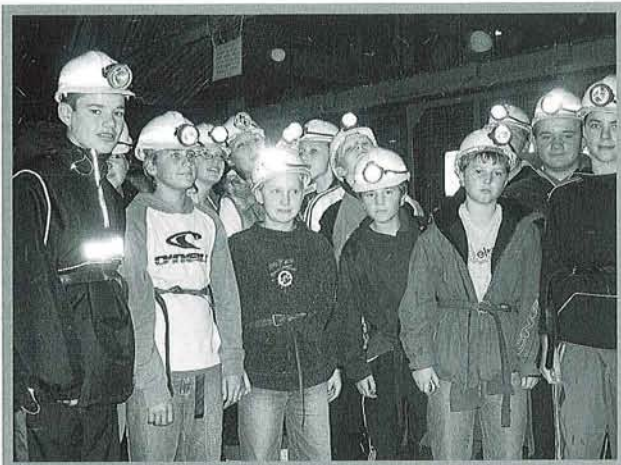

participate in, and to contribute to, as many extra-curricular activities as possible.

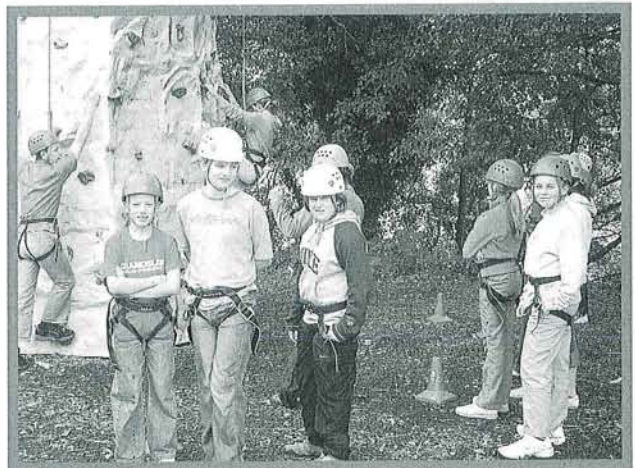

Some Other School Policies

Discipline

The ethos of our school is based on respect for all individuals who belong to the community, be they teachers, other staff or pupils. Happiness within the school community is dependent on high expectations. Self-respect, respect for others, courtesy, kindness, sensitivity, consistency and fairness are the foundation of the life of the school. Our discipline stems from following this philosophy. We strive to develop the principle of self-discipline by raising awareness of each individual's responsibility for his/her own actions.

School Uniform

The school has an official school uniform. A list is supplied at the New Parents Meeting during the Summer Term.

Complaints procedures

It is suggested that the seeking of a solution to any problem that might arise should start with an informal discussion with the Headteacher or other members of staff. Every effort will be made at these discussions to resolve the problem. However, if a satisfactory result is not obtained, then an official procedure may be followed. Full details of this procedure may be obtained in the Home-School Agreement which is distributed annually to parents.

Charging for activities policy

In general the policy of the Governing Body is

- not to charge for education during school hours
- to seek voluntary contributions for educational visits during the school day – without this most visits would not be possible
- to offer assistance with the payment of charges for board and lodging provided for pupils on residential trips in school hours if the parents are in receipt of Income Support or Family Credit
- for pupils who choose to receive instrumental tuition, a charge of £15 per term is required as a contribution towards the cost of these lessons.

Sports and games lessons are an integral part of the curriculum in every year. Ethos, Values and Care in the School

- 'The school places much emphasis on creating a caring and supportive ethos for all pupils and students without exception. Pupils, students and parents alike praise the school's friendly and supportive atmosphere. Subject teachers, class tutors, heads of year and the Senior Management Team work together in particularly close conjunction to weave a safety net of academic and pastoral support and thus pupils are very well guided.'
- 'Pupils' and students' moral development is outstanding. They show much respect towards one another, their teachers and visitors. They know the difference between good and evil and how this has a bearing on lives.'
- 'Pupils' and students' social awareness is very good. They relate very well to one another and to teachers and other members of staff. Students in the sixth form are given opportunities to undertake responsibilities and pupils throughout the school have many opportunities to contribute to the school's social life. Within the 'Life' programme, citizenship is addressed and this is reinforced when pupils and students are given opportunities to voice their opinions. In the School Council, due consideration is paid regularly to their views and they are taken seriously.'

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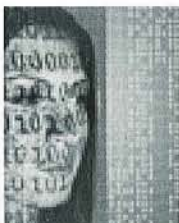
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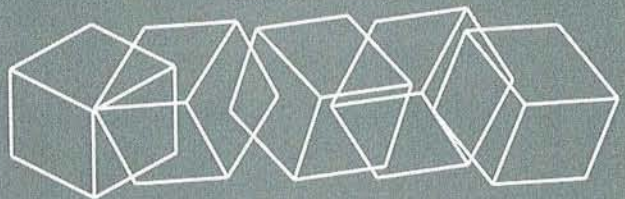
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
