**Solid:** These races are not considered competitive and are not likely to become closely contested. **Likely:** These seats are not considered competitive at this point but have the potential to

become engaged.

**Lean:** These are considered competitive races but one party has an advantage.

**Toss-Up:** These are the most competitive races; either party has a good chance of winning.
