<u>Vermont's Highway System:</u> The Guide describes the major highways serving each region. Not all roads are listed. Consult <u>www.vermontroads.com</u> regarding highway conditions.

<u>Vermont's Official Welcome and Travel Information Centers.</u> Vermont has several strategically placed welcome and travel information centers that are staffed and which have printed travel information. Please consult the region listings, on the following pages, for locations. Hours of operation are extensive, but are not 24-hour service. Local travel plazas, generally located at tourist sites and within downtowns, which display maps and travel information, supplement the travel and welcome centers. The State's system of official business directory signs are the black and white signs and are designed to preserve the scenic beauty of the state at the same time conveying valuable travel information.

<u>Airports and Airlines.</u> Vermont is served by all major airlines at several locations. Please consult the following pages for service details.

<u>Passenger Rail.</u> Vermont is service by Amtrak, with daily service, at many locations within Vermont. Commuter Rail service exists in Chittenden County. Tourist railways also operate at Bellows Falls, and Manchester, VT. Please consult the following pages for service details.

<u>Intercity Bus Service.</u> Vermont Transit, a subsidiary of Greyhound, provides extensive service throughout Vermont and New England. Bonanza Bus, is Vermont's second major intercity bus operator, serving the southwest part of the state. AdventureEast is a new operation offering bus service between NYC and various resorts. Consult the following pages for service locations.

<u>Public Transit Service.</u> Several public transit operators, all funded through local support, State transportation funds and FTA funds serve Vermont. Please consult the following pages for service locations.

<u>Taxi and Limousine Service.</u> Taxi and limousine service are generally not regulated in Vermont, beyond standard motor vehicle safety. The City of Burlington does license taxis and those licenses are noted in the guide. Taxi services listed reflect advertised services and it is advised that you confirm those services directly. Taxi services for Burlington Airport are licensed to operate out of that location and only those licensed services are listed for that location.

Vermont's Islands and Farms Region (Grand Isle, St. Albans and Franklin County Area)

Highways

- I-89 bisects the region, with exits in Fairfax, Georgia, St. Albans, Swanton, and Highgate. The highway runs north to Canada and southwest through Vermont and NH, connecting with I-91 and I-93.
- US 7 runs north and south along the western part of the region, going south to MA and CT and north to Canada.
- I-87 runs along the western border of NY, across Lake Champlain from the region. Access to the region from I-87 is by way of the Lake Champlain Ferry see below and the Rouses Pt. Bridge (US 2 and SR 78).
- Other major routes include US 2 (runs the full length of Grand Isle County running near the Lake Champlain Ferry and connecting with I-89), SR 78 (connecting Grand Isle with Swanton, Highgate and I-87)
