

Dumai-Melaka Cable completed

NEC has successfully completed Dumai – Melaka Cable System (DMCS) on 18 December 2004 and handed over to PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia, Tbk and Telekom Malaysia Berhad. Both companies will use the system as the main infrastructure for their international traffic needs for Internet, voice and data transmission between Indonesia and Malaysia.



The project, a full turn-key repeaterless system spanning 150 kilometers connecting Dumai (Indonesia) and Melaka (Malaysia), has been completed in six months and is initially equipped to transmit a capacity of 20 Gbps and upgradeable up to 320 Gbps.

NEC's state of the art DWDM submarine technology has been utilized. NEC has been contributing to network diversification in Asian region, and NEC supplied Thailand – Indonesia – Singapore (TIS) Cable System in 2003.

The inauguration ceremony was held in Melaka and Jakarta on 17 February 2005, attended by Ministers and company executives from both countries.
