



REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES IN THE NORTH LONDON BOROUGHS

NOTICE is given today, 22 March 2001, under the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986, as amended, that the Boundary Commission for England propose that the North London Boroughs be divided into the following constituencies (2000 electorates in brackets): -

BARKING AND DAGENHAM, AND HAVERING

BARKING BOROUGH CONSTITUENCY (73,809). Eleven wards of the London Borough of **Barking and Dagenham**:- Abbey, Becontree, Chadwell Heath, Eastbury, Gascoigne, Heath, Longbridge, Mayesbrook, Parsloes, Valence, Whalebone.

DAGENHAM AND RAINHAM BOROUGH CONSTITUENCY (69,894). Six wards of the London Borough of **Barking and Dagenham**:- Alibon, Eastbrook, Goresbrook, River, Thames, Village; three wards of the London Borough of **Havering**:- Elm Park, Rainham and Wennington, South Hornchurch.

HORNCHURCH AND UPMINSTER BOROUGH CONSTITUENCY (69,592). Seven wards of the London Borough of **Havering**:- Cranham, Emerson Park, Hacton, Harold Wood, Hylands, St Andrew's, Upminster.

The Commission wish to stress that these provisional recommendations relate solely to parliamentary constituencies and do not affect the structure or arrangements of local government or the services they provide.

The existing constituencies were created by the Parliamentary Constituencies (England) Order 1995, altered by the Parliamentary Constituencies (England) (Miscellaneous Changes) Order 1996, and came into effect at the general election held in May 1997. Four of the existing constituencies in North London will be amended at the next general election by the Parliamentary Constituencies (England) (Miscellaneous Changes) Order 1998 following an interim review held by the Commission in 1997.
