

## Enlargement of AUN Membership

The ASEAN University Network (AUN) was established in November 1995 with 13 universities from 7 member countries. With the admission of the Union of Myanmar and Lao P.D.R. into ASEAN in June 1997 and the inclusion of Kingdom of Cambodia in May 1999, ASEAN expanded to 10 member countries. Consequently, the AUN membership increased to 17 member universities as it is today.
