Steel frame, Gunite; 3 stories over hillside, rectangular, flat roof, interior chimney, horizontal bands of windows on all floors, 2-story glass wall section at stairs, suspended balconies, various sections recessed on each floor, modern interiors, site includes 2-story garage, patios, gym and playground areas. International Style. Dramatic landmark of modern design in U.S. by Richard Neutra, Vienna-born architect who came to U.S. in 1923; displays application of industrial components and technology to domestic architecture; built for client who commissioned an earlier modern house from Rudolph Schindler, Neutra's fellow immigrant architect (see also Lovell Beach House, CA). *Private:* HABS.
