

## **Admiral Robert B. Carney Park**

The park is located 23 kilometers east of the U. S. Naval Support Activity, Naples, Italy in a 93-acre extinct volcanic crater. It hosts a 9 hole golf course, an Olympic size outdoor swimming pool/water park, adult softball/baseball fields, little league baseball fields, football and soccer fields, lighted tennis courts, batting cages, an outdoor basketball court, sandlot volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, tent sites, picnic areas, pavilions, a boy/girl scout camp area, cabins, RV sites, a paintball field, a climbing wall, youth center, teen center, snack bar and restaurant.

## **History of Carney Park**

Carney Park was established on May 21, 1966 by the MWR department of NSA Naples. At that time, the park consisted only of what is now the ball fields. It wasn't until September of 1969 that the MWA department of AFSOUTH began the development of the Golf Course. The Golf Course and Carney Park remained separate entities until 1995, when AFSOUTH turned over control of the Golf Course to NSA.

## **Activities & Services**

Carney Park is an excellent "base of operations" for touring central and southern Italy. Many families come to the park to rent a campsite or a

cabin. Then, they plan day trips to one or more of the several extraordinary sights that surround Naples. Guests of the Park often visit Rome, Pompeii, and the Amalfi Coast or they come to just soak up the sun and relax. We encourage guests to call ITT to reserve day trips or to get information on do-it yourself tours of the local sights. ITT offers pick up and drop-off for their day trips right from the park.

If golf is your game, there is a beautiful and challenging 9-hole golf course located inside Carney Park, too. The course and the driving range are open year-round. The full service Pro shop offers club rentals and sales, cart rentals and there is a PGA Golf Pro on staff to help you improve your game.

The Carney Park Community Center is available to rent for parties, group functions and other special events. If that's not enough, the Carney Park pool is a water park, with 7 slides, a kiddie pool, tiki bar and plenty of room to swim, get wet and splash around! The Pool is open Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Carney Park also has two restaurants. The Fairways Bar & Grill, located next to the Golf Pro Shop, is a full service dining facility that

is open year-round. The second restaurant is Noble Roman's. Noble Roman's is more like a "fresh fast food" place. It offers Noble Roman's pizzeria products, hamburgers, fries and a wide variety of beverages. It's open during the summer months only, and features free entertainment on its massive stone patio during most weekends.
