### Affidavit for Search Warrant (continued)

- When they arrived at the house on Republican St., Moulton said that Huff was one of the first people to arrive. He said that Huff pretty much kept to himself, engaged in some small talk, but didn't cause any problems.
- Other guests described Huff as quiet and to himself, but very polite and friendly in those conversations he did have with other guests.
- Just before seven AM, the party was starting to wind down. Jesiah Martin also lives at the Republican St. address. He was getting ready to go to bed, but went to the computer in the kitchen to check his email. The computer sits next to a window that looks out to the front porch of the house. Martin heard loud bangs coming from outside. He thought someone was firing firecrackers. He was concerned that they would disturb the neighbors. He then heard screams. The blinds on the windows were closed. He opened them and looked out. He saw the large man he didn't know, but had seen at the party, (Huff) standing on the porch facing the house. He saw that this man had a shotgun in his hands held at his hip. He said that the man was firing into the front door of the house. He said that the man had a look of contentment on his face—almost a smile as he fired.
- Other witnesses said that the shooter walked calmly through the house, firing both a shotgun and handgun at everyone he saw. At one point he shot a male victim near the front door. The victim went down. He calmly walked to the man and fired a round into the down victim's head at point blank range, killing him.
- Victims were running through the house hiding where they could. The shooter calmly walked through the house, opening doors, looking for victims, firing repeatedly. One victim, hiding under a bed in one of the bedrooms saw the shooters feet as he walked into the room, and heard him say, "I've got enough ammunition to shoot everybody.".
- Alissa Dunn, aged 17, was in an upstairs bathroom with her boyfriend when the shooting started. When the shots were fired, they locked the bathroom doors. They then heard someone try the door. A moment later, a bullet was fired through the door into the bathroom, missing them.
- Many people called 911. Officers responded and arrived within moments of the call. The first officer to arrive saw a white male walking from the scene holding what appeared to be a shotgun. The officer yelled for the subject to drop the gun. The subject put the gun in his mouth and fired, killing himself.
- Detectives tentatively identified the shooter as Huff. He was armed with both the shotgun and a handgun, as wells as bandoliers of shotgun ammunition, and a pouch of .40 caliber ammunition.
- His truck was located nearby. In plain view in the car was at least one AR-15 Assault Rifle, numerous rounds of ammunition for that, and two five gallon gas cans full of gas.
- Detectives determined that he lives at 12320 Roosevelt Ave, NE #302 in Seattle.
- Detectives spoke to the apartment manager about Huff. She said that Huff lives at that address with his identical twin brother. She said they have lived there for some time and have never caused a problem. She described Huff and his brother as very close. She said that the brother, Kane Huff drives a truck that is not where it is normally parked.

One witness at the scene said he thought Kyle Huff may have made a phone call shortly before coming back with the weapons, but that is unclear at this point.

The fact that Kyle Huff had as much weaponry as he had indicates that he either had plans to carry out and attack like this, or someone brought it to him just prior to the shooting.

Your affiant requests a warrant to search the address at 12023 Roosevelt Way NE #302 for evidence of the crime of murder including weapons and ammunition, explosives or other hazardous material, papers, diaries or other written material (including any computer files, hard drives or other virtual material) that may reflect a plan or scheme to commit a crime such as this, or the reason it was done, or who, if anyone, assisted in it's commission. Narcotics or medication that would contribute to the understanding of the mental state of Kyle Huff at the time of this shooting. Papers or other items which would assist in confirming the identity of the suspect in this incident; phone or contact information for next of kin or any other item obviously related to the commission of this crime.
