

North Willamette Watershed District Clackamas, Columbia, (north) Marion, Multnomah, Washington and Yamhill Counties Lakes Stocked with Trout

BENSON LAKE (Multnomah County) - a 40 acre lake located in Benson Lake State Park near the Columbia River. Take the Benson State Park exit just before Multnomah Falls off of I-84 going east.

BETHANY LAKE (Washington County) - a 10 acre pond located at Bethany west of Portland. Take 185th Exit from Hwy 26 north to Bethany.

BLUE LAKE(Multnomah County) - a 64 acre lake east of Portland in Blue Lake Park, 3 miles west of Troutdale. Located north of Hwy 30 and _ mile south of the Columbia River.

CANBY POND (Clackamas County) - a 1 acre pond located on the south end of Canby in Canby City Park. Park is on east side of Hwy 99E.

COLLINS LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 1 acre lake on Hwy 26 west of Government Camp and just south of the old highway. No sign, but lake can be seen from the highway (on north side of road).

COMMONWEALTH LAKE (Washington County) - a 3 acre lake in Cedar Hills. From the Sunset Hwy take Cedar Hills Blvd. south _ mile. Turn right on Foothills Drive and follow to lake.

DORMAN POND (Washington County) - an 8 acre pond west of Forest Grove at the junction of Hwy 8 and Hwy 6.

ESTACADA LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 150 acre lake on the Clackamas River behind River Mill Dam at Estacada.

FARADAY LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 25 acre lake 2 miles SE of Estacada by way of Hwy 224 on the Clackamas River.

HALDEMAN POND (Columbia County) - a 4 acre pond on Sauvie Island. Take Oak Island Road off of Reeder Rd.

HAMPTON POND (Yamhill County) - From Hwy. 18, take Willamina City Center Exit. Turn left on Main St. Follow Main St. to NE E St. and turn right. Proceed to NE Yamhill St. and turn left. Follow Yamhill St. to pond.

HARRIET LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 23 acre reservoir on Oak Grove Fork of Clackamas River in Mt. Hood Nat'l Forest. Beyond Estacada and Ripple Brook Ranger Station on Forest Service roads.

HENRY HAGG LAKE (Washington County) - a 1,110 acre lake 7 miles SW of Forest Grove off of Hwy 47.

MT. HOOD POND (Multnomah County) - a 5 acre trout pond on campus of Mt. Hood Community College in Gresham.

NORTH FORK RESERVOIR (Clackamas County) - a 350 acre reservoir on the Clackamas River 7 miles south of Estacada off of Hwy 224.

ROSLYN LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 135 acre lake 2 miles NE of Sandy on Dodge Park Rd.

SALMONBERRY LAKE (Columbia County) - a 15 acre lake west of St. Helens. Take Pittsburgh-St. Helens Rd. to turn-off onto access road.

SILVER CREEK RESERVOIR (Marion County) - a 65 acre reservoir on Silver Creek 2.5 miles south of Silverton on Hwy 214.

ST. LOUIS PONDS (Marion County) - 54 developed acres of water in 7 ponds west of Gervais. St Louis Rd west to Terch Lane turn left to ponds.

TIMBER LAKE(Clackamas County) - a 15 acre lake east of Estacada on the Timber Lake Job Corps Center compound just west of Ripplebrook Ranger Station.

TIMOTHY LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 1400 acre lake about 80 miles east of Portland past Mt. Hood. From Hwy 26 turn onto Skyline Rd. (FS42).

TRILLIUM LAKE (Clackamas County) - a 60 acre lake 3 miles east of Government Camp off of Hwy 26.

TROJAN POND (Columbia County) - a 15 acre lake just east of Rainier on the north side of Hwy 30 at the Trojan nuclear facility.

WAHKEENA POND (Multnomah County)- a 20 acre lake located by the Columbia River just before Multnomah Falls off of I-84. Take the Benson Lake State Park exit going east. Pond is on the right.

Note: for more specific directions, check maps; inquire in local communities (e.g., bait and tackle shops, Chambers of Commerce, USFW ranger stations); or consult local fishing publications such as Fishing in Oregon.
