








Accessibility of stations on the SPT rail network 2005










Subway - Train operated kilometres 1996-2005







Local bus registrations by service type 1996-2005






Local bus - Market share 2005









Local bus - Departures from SPT-operated bus stations 2001-2005


Concessionary travel cards in use 1996-2005 As at 31 March. Source: SPT
















Zonecard - Revenue 1997-2005




