# LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> TIFFANY

## "Chicks with Sticks" Doll Sweater and Crochet Playset

Skill Level: Beginner

### SIZE

One size to fit 11½ inch [29.5 cm] fashion doll

### MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Tiffany
  - 1 ball #100 White (A)
- or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Size 8 (5 mm) knitting needles or size to obtain gauge
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle
- Ring from the lid from a milk jug
- Tiny basket (buy in floral section of a craft store)

Note: Product quantity used is small; this is a great project for using up left-over yarn. A single full skein of yarn will make at least 4 copies of this sweater.

### GAUGE

17 sc = 4" (10 cm) with size J-10 (6 mm) hook

### SWEATER

#### Body

Ch 24.

Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in each ch across – 24 sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Rep last row until piece measures 2½ inches [6.5 cm]. End off. Cut yarn, leaving a trailing end of about 8 inches [20 cm] of yarn when cutting the extra yarn.

#### Sleeves

##### Make 2

Ch 12.

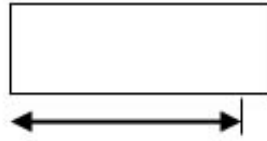
Row 1 Sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in each ch across – 24 sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Rep until piece measures 3" [7.5 cm]. End off. Cut yarn, leaving a trailing end of about 8 inches [20 cm] of yarn when cutting the extra yarn.

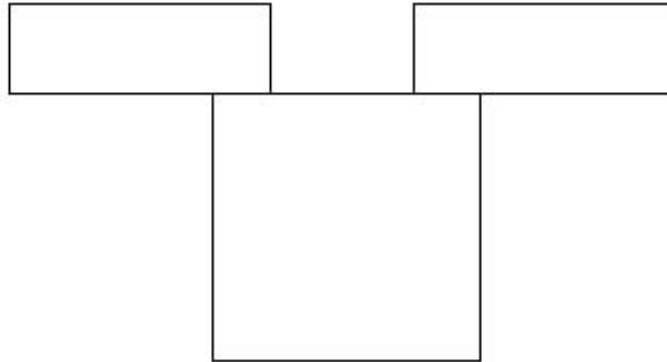
### FINISHING

Sew front and back of sweater together to make a tube.

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1. Sew sleeve together, leaving about 1/4 inch unsewn at one end



2. Position the sleeve as shown on the bodice, spread the unsewn portion of the sleeve and sew to the bodice as shown.

Tie off securely, cut and wave in ends.



### **CROCHET HOOK**

The tiny crochet hook was made from the ring that secures the milk jug lid (and that has to be removed when opening the jug). We used scissors to cut it to shape.

### KNITTING BASKET

Purchased at *Michael's: The Arts and Craft Store* in the floral section.

### MINIATURE YARN BALLS

Use any kind of lightweight yarn to create yarn ball and skeins. For these skeins, we unraveled about 4 feet of Lion Wool into its four separate strands, got them damp, ironed them to make them straight and then wrapped them into skeins. We made labels, cut them to size, wrapped them and secured them with tape. Click [here](#) to download the miniature Lion Brand labels to print on your color printer.
