The VAB recognized four individuals and 69 stations for outstanding accomplishments during the 2004 VAB Awards Ceremony held Friday, June 24, at the Cavalier Hotel in Virginia Beach. Of the 69 stations participating, 12 stations won more than one award, and nine stations won more than two awards. WAAM/WSVG of Woodstock and WVEC-TV of Norfolk both collected four awards. WFTR-AM of Front Royal, WINC-AM/FM of Winchester, WINA-AM of Charlottesville, WWBT-TV of Richmond, WRXL-FM of Richmond, and WRVA-AM of Richmond all accepted three awards.

The Distinguished Virginian Award was presented to Admiral Harold W. Gehman for his substantial contributions to the well-being of the Nation or the Commonwealth.

Admiral Gehman, who retired in September 2000 as NATO's Supreme Allied Commander-Atlantic and Commander-in-Chief of the United States Joint Forces Command, is a career military man with over 35 years of active duty in the U.S. Navy. He came out of retirement, however, in October 2002 to lead the investigation into the terrorist bombing of the USS Cole. In February 2003, he was tapped to lead a special government commission to investigate the Columbia space shuttle disaster.

The George Bowles Broadcast Journalism Award recognized Ed Hughes, who was known as "The Walter Cronkite of Hampton Roads" for distinguished performance in broadcast news. Hughes, who worked at WTKR in almost every capacity and then as anchor, died June 1, 2004, at age 66, after a battle with cancer. The award was accepted by Hughes' son, Ed Hughes, IV.

The C.T. Lucy Distinguished Service Award was presented to Brad Eure, of Charlottesville to recognize his career in broadcasting and service to the industry and the association. Eure is president and general manager of Eure Communications Inc. in Charlottesville, Virginia. Eure Communications Inc. owns WINA, WQMZ, WWWV radio stations in Charlottesville, and WNBR, Windsor, North Carolina, and is the majority owner of WNBB, New Bern, North Carolina.

The J. Jerry Freeman Engineering Award went to Vernon Baker for excellence in the field of broadcast engineering and his direct support of broadcasting, having been engaged in broadcast engineering work or contract engineering serving Virginia radio stations for decades. In 1958, he constructed the first commercial radio station in Christiansburg, WBCR-AM. In the years that followed, Vernon built 41 radio stations and purchased seven. Today his son, Edward. A. Baker, is involved in the management and engineering of these stations.
