ABOUT DAVID C. ONLEY

Mr David Charles Onley was paralyzed with polio at the age of three. He has been a lifelong advocate for ability, a cause he will continue to champion as Lieutenant Governor while serving as an encouraging role model for disabled people, especially for youth.

Mr Onley was Ontario's first reporter with a disability and has worked as a journalist/host at Citytv/CP24 for the past 22 years. His tireless volunteer work has advanced the cause of the disabled in the province and throughout the country. For his efforts, he received an honorary doctorate and was inducted into the Terry Fox Hall of Fame. In 2005, he was appointed Chair of the Accessibility Standards Advisory Council to the Minister of Community and Social Services.

Mr Onley lives in Scarborough with his wife, Ruth Ann, and their three sons.
