Farrer Memorial Agricultural High School is a NSW Government Selective Agricultural High School for boys Years 7-12, situated on 191 hectares, 10 kilometres from Tamworth.

Farrer has 350 boarders and 260 dayboys. The school was named to perpetuate the memory of William James Farrer, famous for his investigations into wheat. The study of Agriculture at Farrer MAHS has an enriched cultural and academic perspective tailored for students whose vocation may be associated with the science of agriculture or those who intend to become farmers and graziers.

Sport participation and representation form an integral and essential part of the "Farrer Experience". The school has excellent sporting facilities including a gymnasium, swimming pool, weights room, tennis courts, basketball courts, football fields and a cricket oval with practice nets. Coaches also make regular use of the city's sporting facilities, especially the synthetic hockey surface and athletics track.

Farrer's enriched academic, social, sporting and extra-curricular approach to education underpinned by the values of loyalty, respect, trust and responsibility develops young men of excellent character and service.
