


## **School Overview 2007**

## Introduction

St Peters Lutheran College was established in 1945 by the Lutheran Church to provide Christian co-education. Fundamental to St Peters is our concern for 'growing people', both individually and collectively. In the Christian culture of St Peters, all people are expected to deal with each other with a high level of care, dignity and respect. All people are also expected to use their God-given talents and abilities to achieve their individual and our community goals successfully. St Peters is a school of confidence, achievement and success - an exciting place to be.

St Peters is uniquely situated on a 21-hectare site at Indooroopilly. Natural forest areas have been conserved and attract diverse populations of native plants, birds and animals. This provides an enjoyable environment for learning.

With the Junior, Middle, Junior High and Senior Schools all located on the same campus, students enjoy a continuity of surroundings, teachers and friends, allowing them to progress through their education with a sense of community and belonging.

St Peters has 61 years' experience in boarding and is the only co-educational boarding school in the wider Brisbane area. St Peters cares for boarders from Year 6 to Year 12 and day students from Preparatory to Year 12. Brothers and sisters are able to attend the same school and experience its diverse educational, social, sporting and cultural opportunities in an environment that cares for the individual. Boys and girls learn to interact maturely and with respect in a co-educational environment that carefully and caringly manages social development.

Computer education has been part of the St Peters since 1974. Students are introduced to computers from the Prep year. The College has a large computer network using Microsoft Windows, with all students having access to the Internet and their own email address. There are 10 computer laboratories. The College is continually upgrading its facilities to meet the demands of the 21st Century.
