### Travel tips

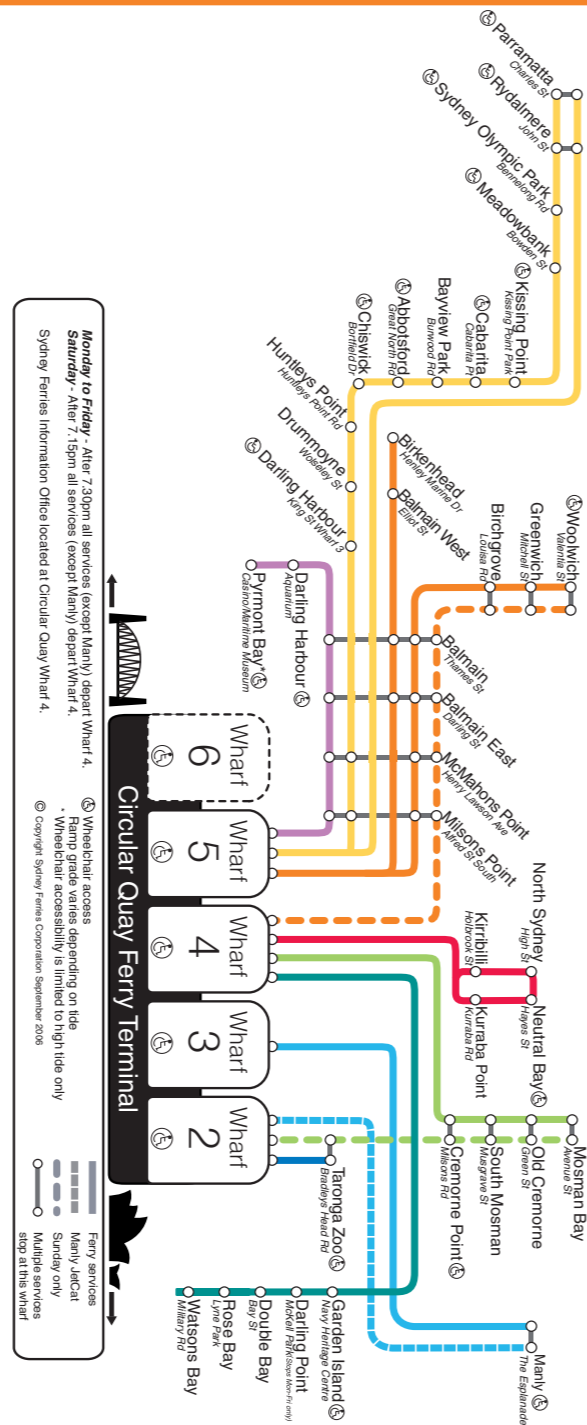
- Be ready for boarding five minutes before the departure time – allow additional time to purchase your ticket

Wheelchair access Ramp grade varies depending on tide. Wheelchair accessibility is limited to high tide only.  
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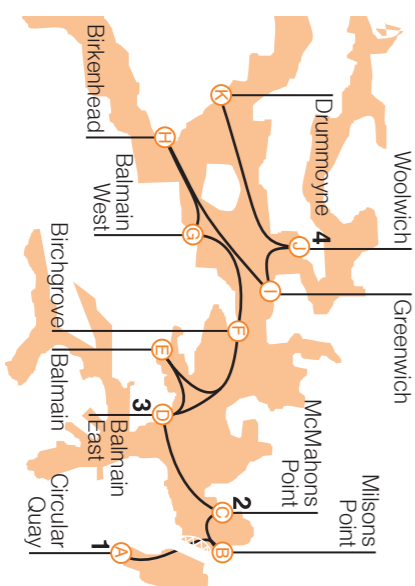
### Things to see and do

- 1. Circular Quay** - The gateway to Sydney, the Royal Botanic Gardens and the Opera House. Also home to the historic pubs and restaurants of The Rocks.
