Prewar 4,400 Megawatts (MW)

05 Oct 03 4,417 MW (met initial goal of 4,400 MW)

Summer 04 6,000 MW (estimated summer peak demand)



- CPA ME currently reassessing the plan for reaching 6,000 MW by Summer 04 with July as the target date
- Significant power outage on 14 Dec due to numerous unrelated generator outages at several plants. Power production recovered to 3,344 MW on 17 Dec Data as of 19 Dec UNCLASSIFIED

administrators trained in modern teaching methods

- Minister of Education (MOE) met with political parties, religious groups and higher-education community representatives on curriculum reform
- Rehabilitated 1,982 out of 11,939 damaged schools
- · Continuing to build technical capacity of MOE

# Health Care

## **Milestones**

- Apr 04: Electronic health surveillance program initiated
- Jun 04: Model health care clinics established emphasizing prevention and disease management
- End 04: 90% of all children receive routine immunizations
- End 04: Infant mortality rate reduced by half to 50 / 1,000



#### **Current Activities**

- President Bush discussed improvements in Iraq's health services with the Iraqi Interim Minister of Health, Dr. Khudair Abbas, and six other Iraqi physicians at the White House on 15 Dec
- Countrywide training program on primary care best practices and training techniques (special emphasis on life saving / child survival)

#### Facts about the New Iraqi Healthcare System


- Iraq at pre-war capabilities for providing health care -- 240 Iraqi hospitals and more than 1,200 primary health clinics are operating
- Ministry has 100,000 healthcare professionals / staff (Over 80% women)

# Governance

## **Milestones**

- 15 Nov 03: New agreement between CPA and Governing Council on transition process
  - Drafting and approval of Transitional Administrative Law complete by 28 Feb 04
  - Approval of bilateral security agreements complete by 31 Mar 04
  - Transitional National Assembly will be elected no later than 31 May 04
- 30 Jun 04: New transitional administration recognized by CPA will assume full sovereign powers for governing Iraq; CPA and GC dissolve

#### **Current Activities**

- Seven women were nominated as candidates for neighborhood councils in Al Hillah this week
- Buhriz has begun selection of neighborhood and district councils
- National Mine Action Authority and Mine Action Center began first national humanitarian de-mining campaign in Iraq



# **Economics**

## Financial Markets

- The new Traqi dinar has appreciated by 5% since the capture of Saddam Hussein, settling at \$1 = NID 1,740
- 5.4 trillion new Iraqi dinars; 86% of the total issued are currently in Iraq
- Dec 5: Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance hosted a signing ceremony between CPA, Trade Bank of Iraq and sixteen Export Credit Agencies in Rome
- Central Bank of Iraq (CBI) will extend deadline for Foreign Banking License applications from 26 Nov to 04 Dec due to the Eid al-Fitr holiday marking the end of Ramadan

#### **Private Sector Development**

 Under USAID's Community Action Program, International Relief and Development has committed \$8.39 million to 279 income and employment generation projects in Baghdad

#### Oil for Food Program Transition

- CPA assumed full control of the Oil For Food Program on 21 Nov 03, and the transition went smoothly
- CPA will continue the prioritization process for approved and funded contracts beyond 21 Nov
