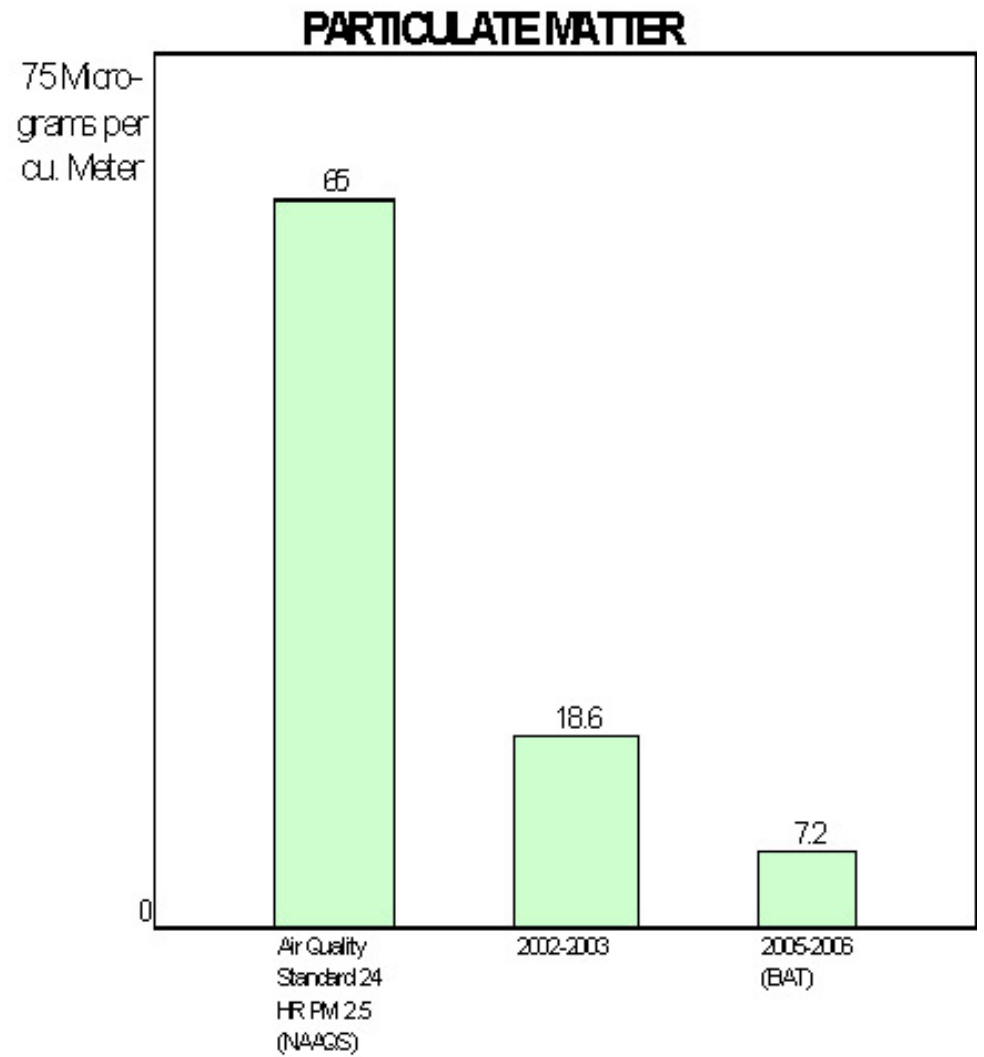

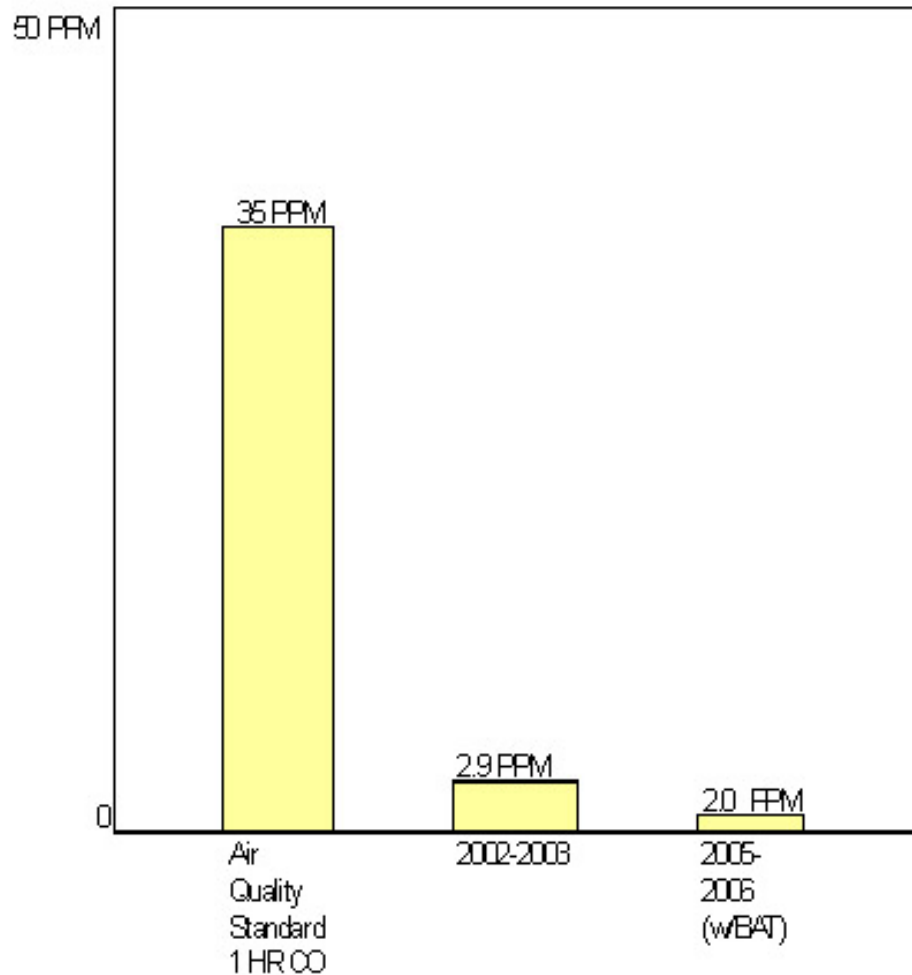

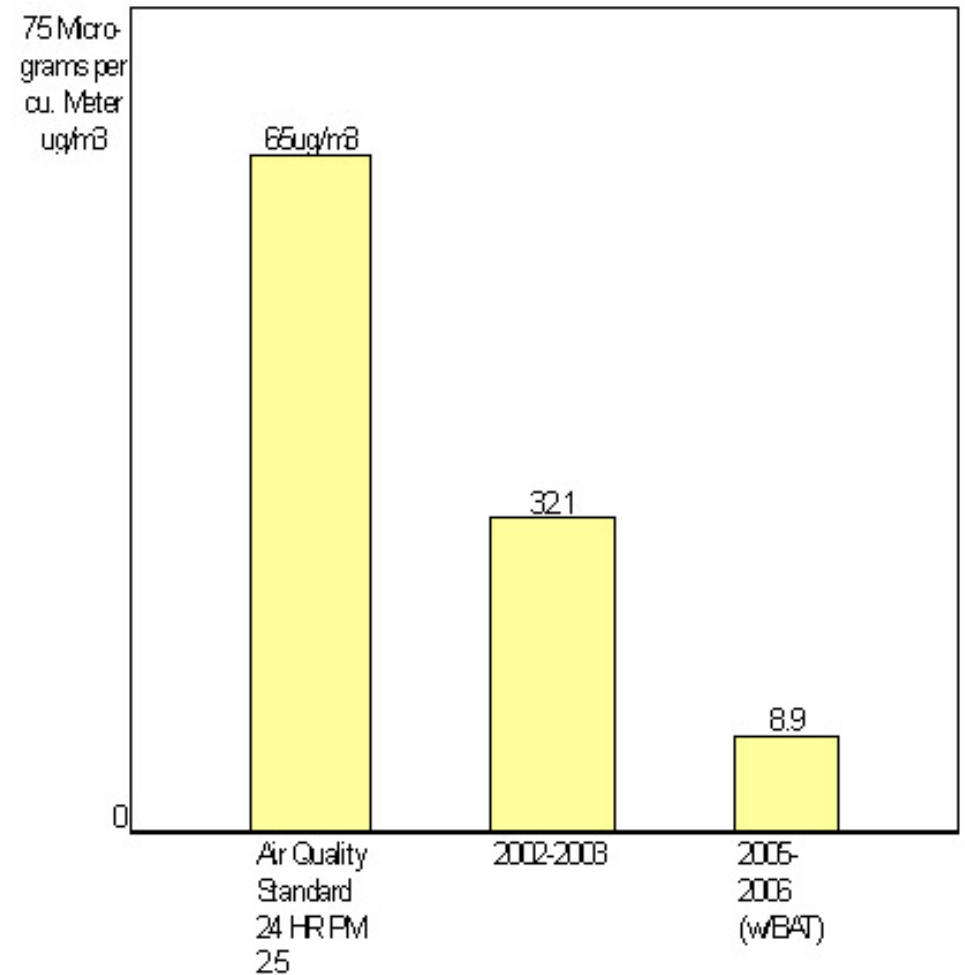

CARBON MONOXIDE

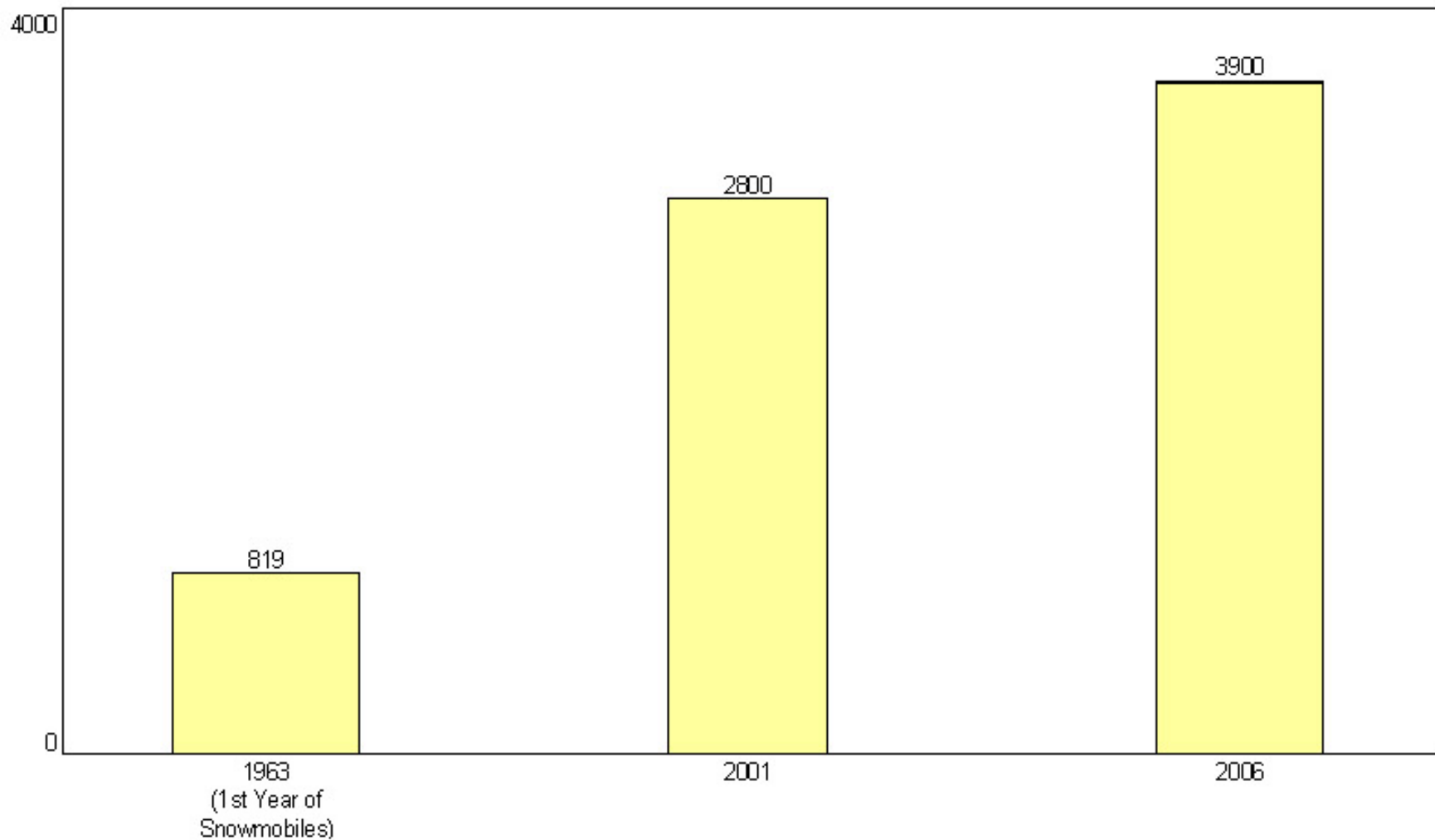

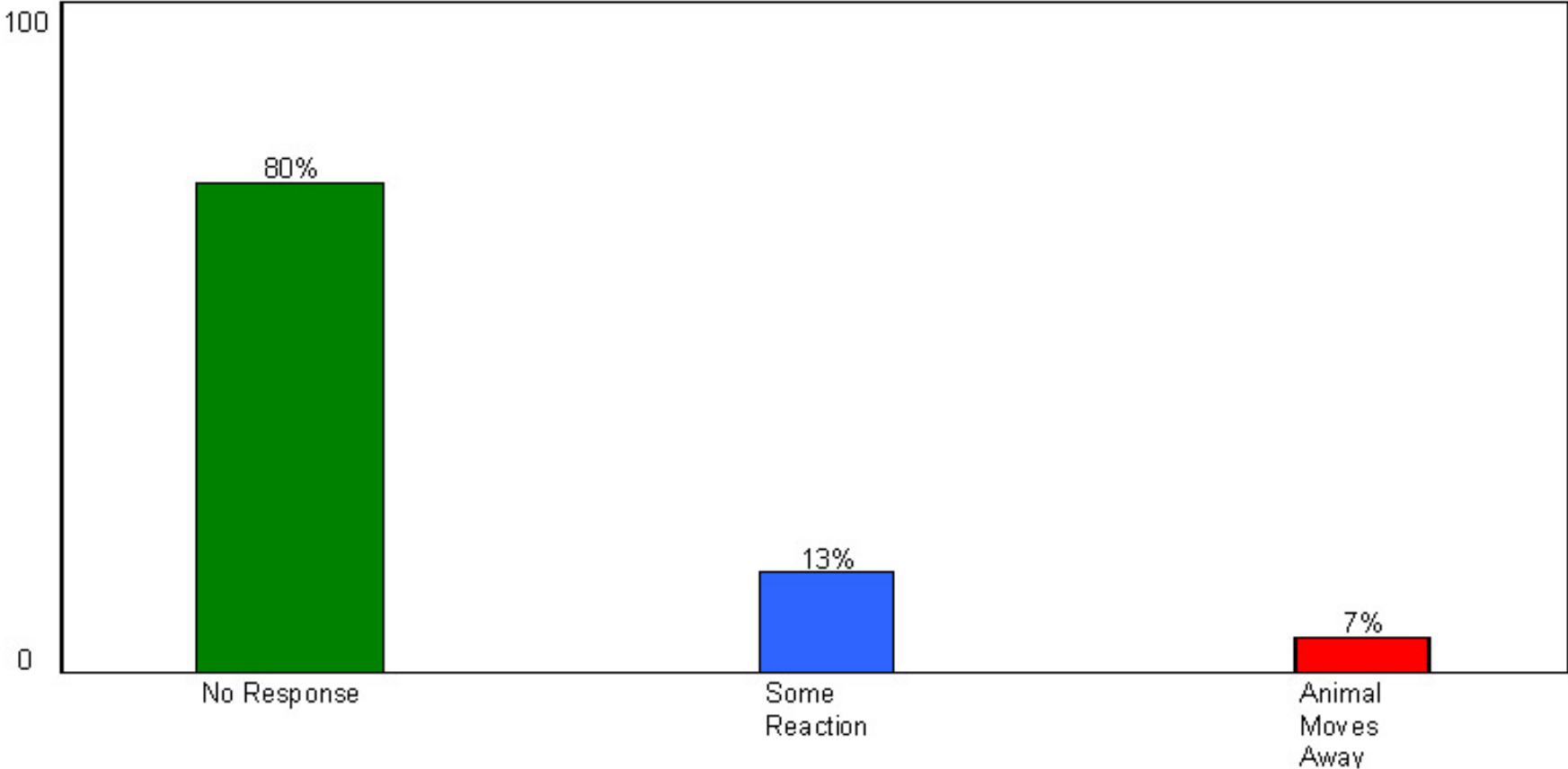
BISON POPULATION – YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

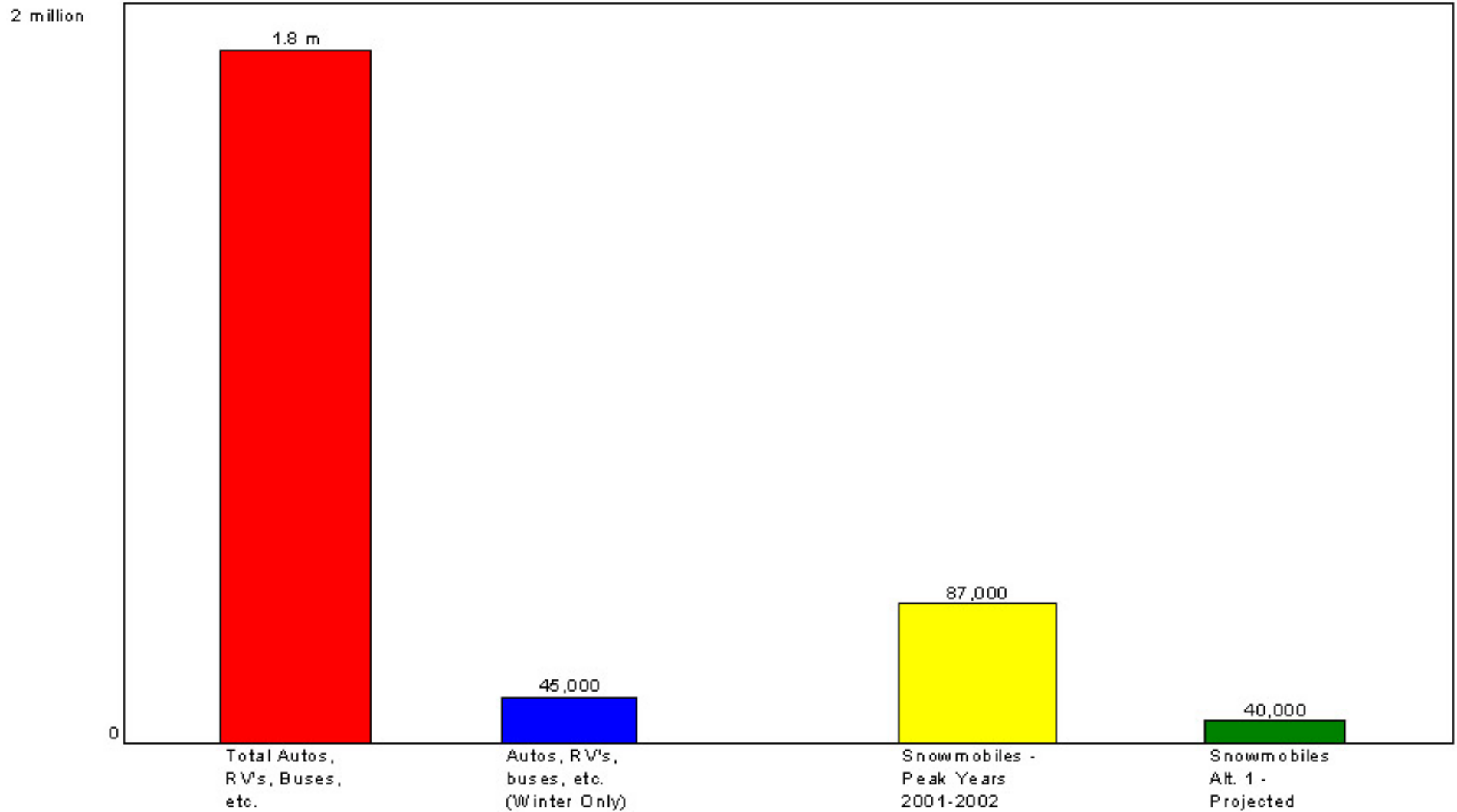
BISON RESPONSE TO SNOWMOBILES ON ROAD SYSTEM

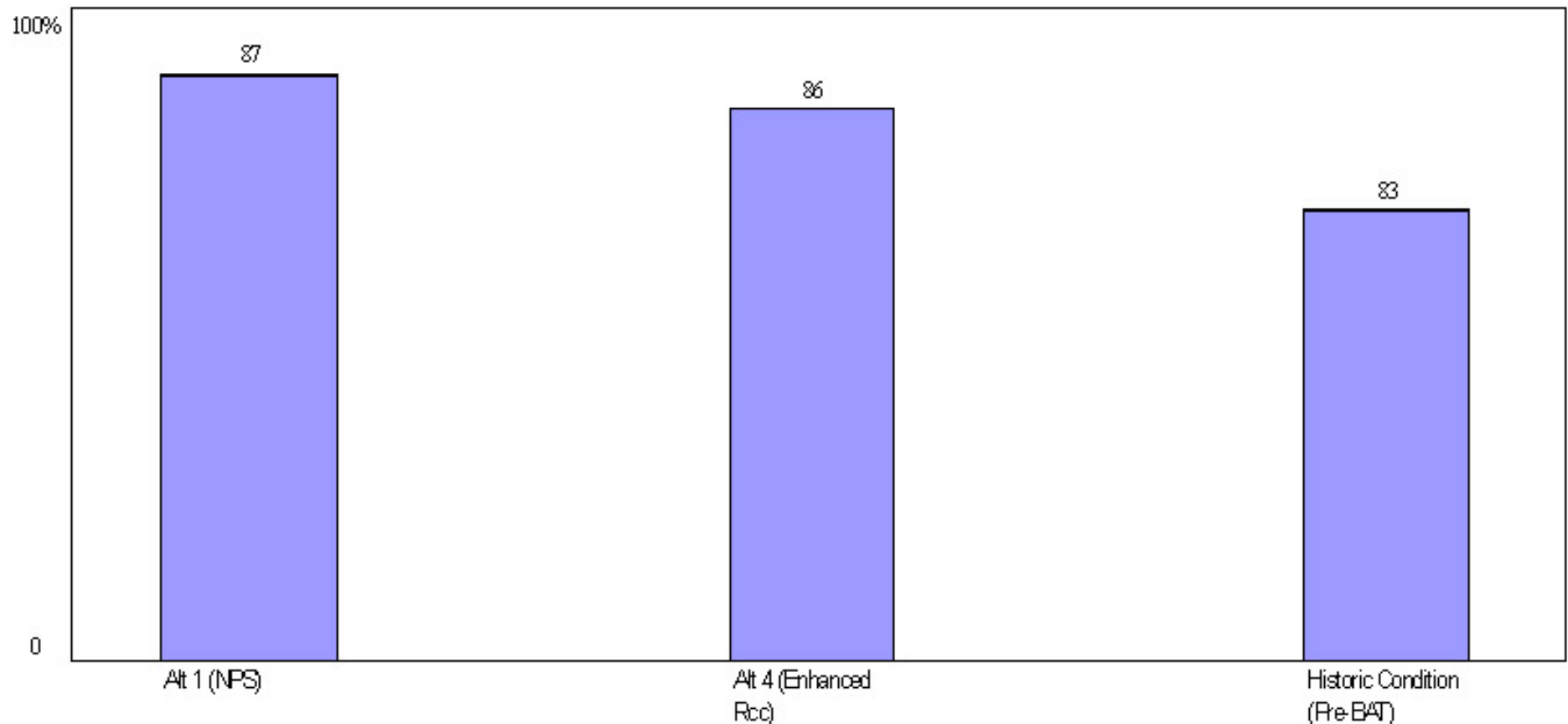
MOTOR VEHICLE VISITATION - YELLOWSTONE

SNOWMOBILE SOUND EFFECTS IN YELLOWSTONE

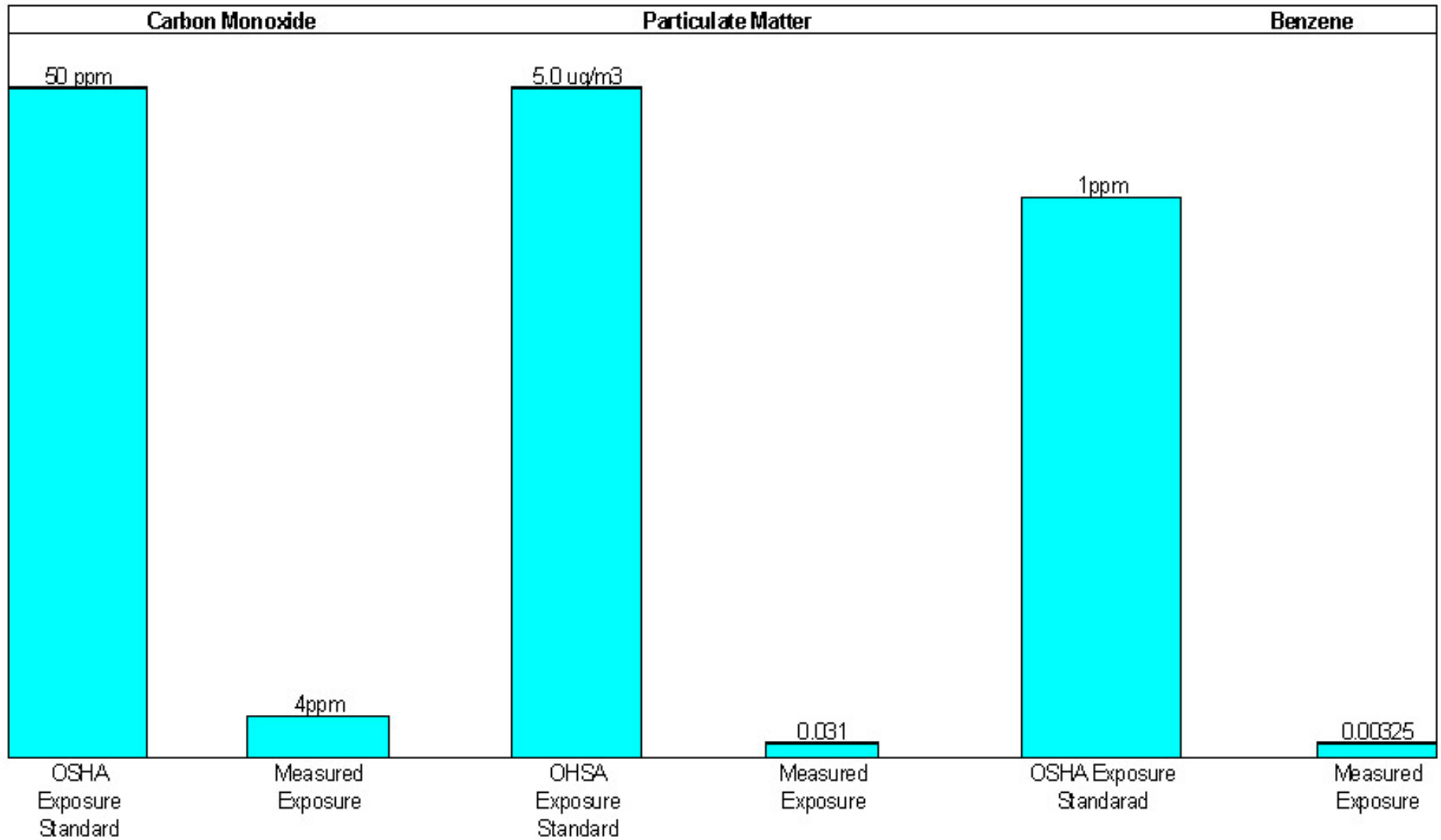
% of Park Where Snowmobiles are NOT AUDIBLE
