




# Liverpool Loop Closure



# 21 April until 28 May 2007

# Major Engineering work on the Liverpool Loop section of the Wirral Line

Further investment on Merseyside by Network Rail, the company that maintains the UK's railway track and signalling, continues throughout 2007. During mid April and May, engineering work will affect train services on the Liverpool Loop section of the Wirral Line.

## Closure details

Due to essential track improvement works by Network Rail around the Liverpool Loop section of the Wirral Line, trains will not operate from Saturday 21 April through to Monday 28 May 2007.



For the first two days (Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 April) and last three days (Saturday 26 to Monday 28 May) of the engineering works, trains will operate as normal Birkenhead North to/from West Kirby/New Brighton or Birkenhead Central to/from Chester/Ellesmere Port, then rail replacement bus services will connect with trains to take passengers via Birkenhead Hamilton Square to Liverpool City Centre.

From Monday 23 April to Friday 25 May, trains will operate as normal to/from James Street station. A rail replacement bus service will operate between James Street and Lime Street only.

A calendar showing the breakdown of the works over the 6-week period can be found on page 3. Pages 4 and 5 show train departure times from James Street\* station. Pages 6 and 7 provide information on getting around the City Centre, including a map showing a suggested walking route to Moorfields station for onward travel on the Northern Line, and page 8 has general information.

\* **Please note:** departures are split between two platforms at James Street station. Please check on pages 4 and 5 which platform your train is leaving from.

Trains will operate as normal from New Brighton to Birkenhead North; West Kirby to Birkenhead North; Chester/Ellesmere Port to Birkenhead Central, then rail replacement bus services will operate to Liverpool City Centre.

On Monday to Saturday, trains will operate to a Saturday timetable, and on Sunday a Sunday timetable from New Brighton, West Kirby, Chester, Ellesmere Port via Hamilton Square to James Street. **Trains will not serve Moorfields, Lime Street or Liverpool Central**. Rail replacement bus services will operate from James Street to Lime Street Station only.\*

On Monday to Saturday, trains will operate to a Saturday timetable, and on Sunday a Sunday timetable from New Brighton, West Kirby, Chester and Ellesmere Port via Hamilton Square to James Street.

Trains will not serve Moorfields, Lime Street or Liverpool Central. Rail replacement bus services will operate from James Street to Lime Street station only.\* Last trains will be replaced by buses on these dates.

Normal service on these days.

<sup>\*</sup> **Valid** Trio, Trioplus, Saveaway, Railpass, Free Travel Passes and individual train tickets can be used on the rail replacement bus services.

#### Sundays 29 April to 20 May 2007

All trains to Chester and Ellesmere Port depart from Platform 2.

**Please note:** on Sunday **13 May 2007**, there will be engineering work between **Rock Ferry** and **Hooton** until 1300. Until this time, trains from Platform 2 will terminate at Rock Ferry to connect with a rail replacement bus service. The first through trains from James Street station will be 1301 to Chester and 1316 to Ellesmere Port.

# How to get around Liverpool City Centre

To connect with Northern Line trains to Southport/Hunts Cross, Kirkby and Ormskirk the following walking route (see map on page 7) is suggested:

#### James Street to Moorfields

Walk along James Street, then left onto Castle Street (towards Town Hall), right onto Dale Street, cross Dale Street and then left onto Moorfields.


A rail replacement bus service will operate to/from James Street, stopping only outside St George's Hall for Lime Street station, to connect with City Line long distance services.

You could also use the FerryLink S2 and S3 bus services which operate around the City Centre. Rail users transferring to/from the train to the FerryLink S2 and S3 services also get 'free' travel when presenting a valid rail ticket showing 'to/from Liverpool stations' to the bus driver.

There are many other bus services running from James Street via Lord Street, and Victoria Street to Queen Square Bus Station. Valid Trio, Trioplus, Saveaway and Free Travel Passes will be accepted on these services but please note that rail tickets cannot be used on these services.

Please allow extra time for your journey, especially if you are connecting to other train services.





# **General information**

#### Passenger help points and telephones

All Merseyrail stations have public telephones and rail information/emergency help points. These can be used at any time to obtain further information or emergency assistance.

#### **Prams and Dogs**

Prams, pushchairs and dogs will be carried at the discretion of the bus driver.

#### **Cycles**

Cycles **cannot** be carried on the buses.

## **Disabled travellers**

Most buses used for the rail replacement services will be fully accessible. However, if you think that you may have a problem during the closures, ring the Merseyrail 'Mobility' helpline, in advance, on **0151 702 2071** and they will try to make alternative arrangements to assist you with your journey.

Taxis will be available at James Street and Lime Street stations for those with mobility needs. If you require assistance please contact the station staff.

If you need help with your journey, please give them at least one hour's notice.

# Tickets and passes

Please buy your ticket at the station booking office as normal before starting your journey - **you will not be able to buy a ticket on the bus!**All valid rail, Trio, Trioplus, Saveaway and Free Travel Passes will be accepted on buses for the appropriate journeys.

The information contained in this timetable is believed to be correct at the time of going to print in April 2007.

Changes can, however, be made at short notice and these will be shown on our website at **www.merseytravel.gov.uk**For up-to-date information, passengers should check their service with their local station before they travel.
