## Presidents Letter

Dear Alumni and Friends,

There is a sense of great excitement at Columbus. We just found out that we have been chosen as one of the top 50 Catholic High Schools in the country for a second time. We have 369 new freshmen making our total enrollment over 1,390 students. The big news around campus is that the construction of the much anticipated Mas Technology Complex has commenced. Just last month I watched as crews demolished the steps to the main entrance of the school, the very steps that all of you have passed through since 1958 to receive a quality education. Phase 1 of the construction which includes “Marist Circle” is almost complete and I am proud to say that in our first year of the Adelante with Technology Campaign, we were able to raise \$7.5 million in donations and pledges toward the new facility. As we enter our 2nd year of the campaign we find ourselves having to raise \$4.5 million more.

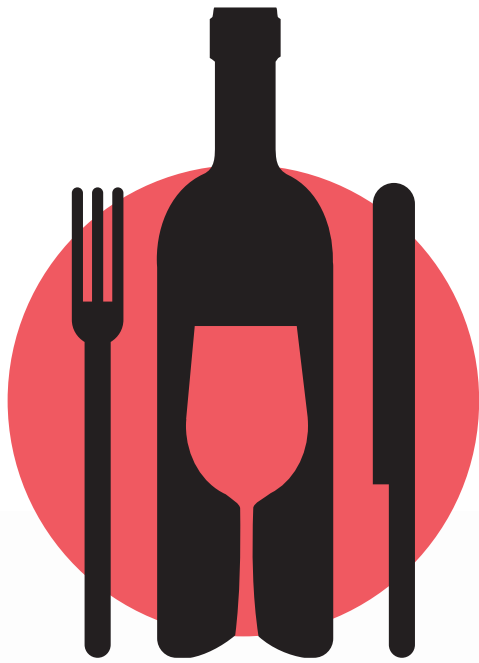

moving on to private practice as a defense attorney.

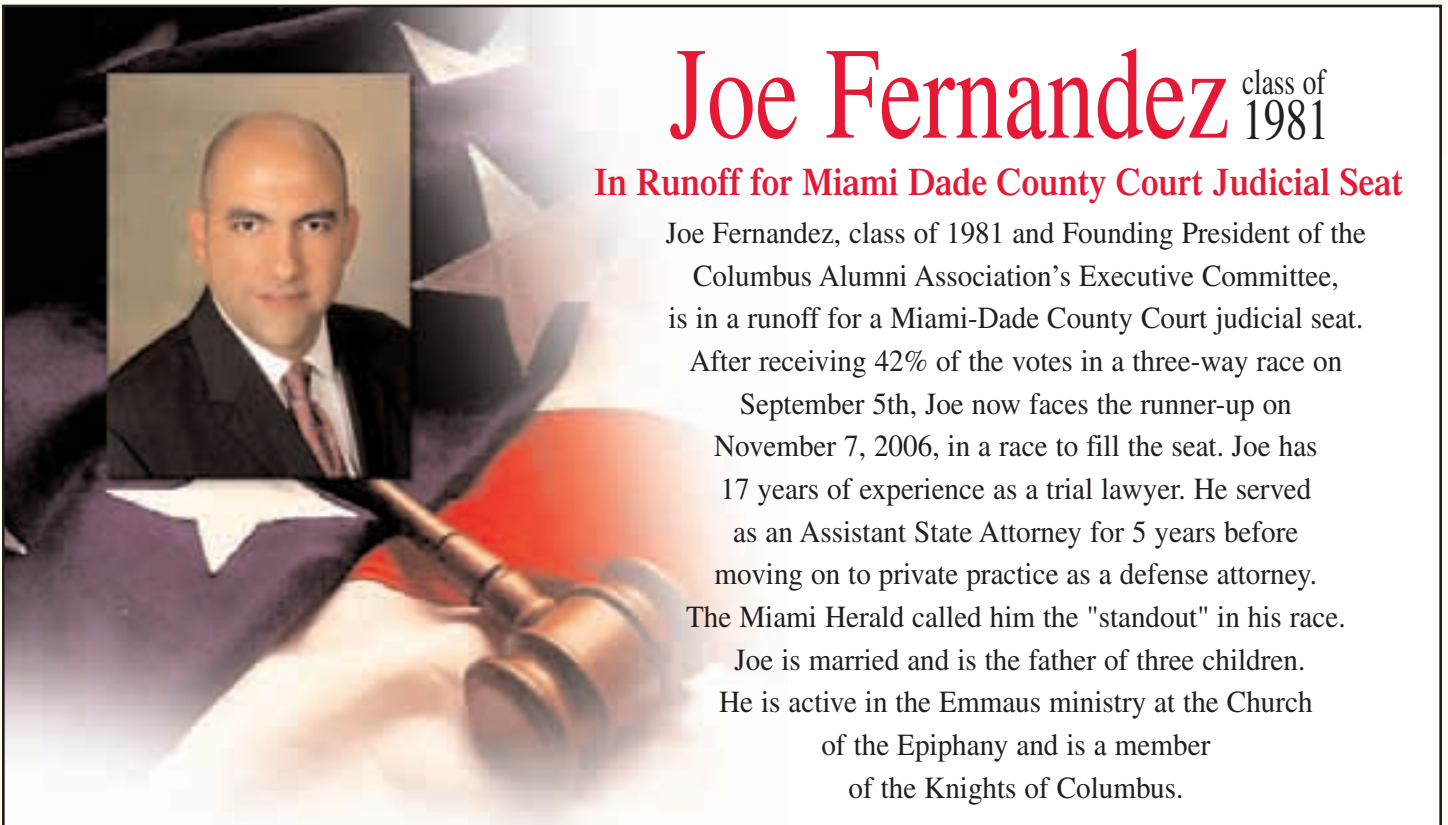
The Miami Herald called him the "standout" in his race.

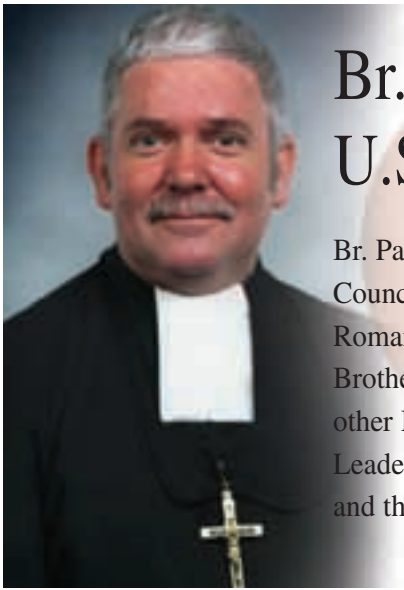

## Faculty Profile:

# Br. Michael Brady

After serving as an administrator and teacher at Marist and Union Catholic high schools in New Jersey for twelve years, Br. Brady arrived at Columbus in 1977 to start teaching religion and history. Ministry and spirituality at Columbus would never be the same. In 1980, together with Fr. Arthur Dennison, Br. Michael started the first Campus Ministry Program at Columbus and served as the school's Campus Ministry Director until 1993. The program was such a success that he was called to return to Marist High School to start their first Campus Ministry Program, but after three years he returned to his dearly loved Columbus to head community service and continue teaching. This was a time when Columbus was growing tremendously and the need for an Admissions Director arose. Since Br. Brady was known for his exceptional organizational and people skills, had great knowledge about the school, and most importantly had such a profound love for Columbus, he was perfect for the job. He became the school's first Admissions Director in 2001, a position that he still holds today.

Over the last five years, under Br. Michael's direction, enrollment has steadily increased at Columbus and today is at a high with approximately 1,400 students. When asked about his experience at Columbus he said "What's most rewarding for me is to see how successful so many of our alumni have become, seeing them form their own families and excited about sending their sons to Columbus."

Originally from Covington, Kentucky, Br. Brady became a Marist Brother in 1960. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Social Studies from Marist College in New York and a Master's degree in Religious Education from Providence College in Rhode Island. He also completed a Marist Spirituality Program which included extensive travel within Italy, France, and Israel in 1998.

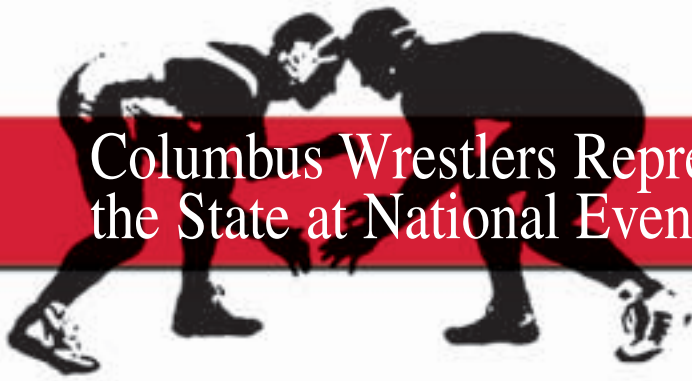

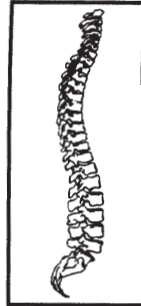

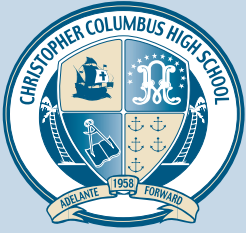
