LisaBartlett: Helga rules. That's all there is to say.

CraigBartlett: i'm writing movie scripts with Joe Purdy

CraigBartlett: several projects at once

CraigBartlett: and I'm making a film for NASA

CraigBartlett: and also some writing of scripts and story bibles for other peoples projects

CraigBartlett: but she still was culty about him.

CraigBartlett: wrote a letter to him every night, but never mailed them.

CraigBartlett: candy! happy halloween

CraigBartlett: and i've said this before...

CraigBartlett: you should not trash them. they will only tune you out. CraigBartlett: try being positive, like "we want the complete DVDs!

CraigBartlett: wow, speaking of MTV

CraigBartlett: my old boss and hero, Tom Freston, was fired from Viacom

CraigBartlett: he created MTV

CraigBartlett: yes, Stephen, always fast.

CraigBartlett: no, the movie plans ended many admistrations of Nick/Paramount ago.

CraigBartlett: the jungle movie?

CraigBartlett: geez, it would have been a long time ago.

CraigBartlett: maybe i was plugging it for something. can't remember

<question> : Hey Craig, do you read the fanfictions for HA!?

CraigBartlett: I haven't read the fanfics in a long time.

CraigBartlett: but they're cool, a good outlet for fans who can never get enough

CraigBartlett: and who want them to be teens!

CraigBartlett : hi fanfic writers

CraigBartlett: you rule!!

CraigBartlett: hey, remember when i was all caps, that time at CN,

CraigBartlett: i'm okay tho <question>: hey craig, CraigBartlett: yes CraigBartlett:?

CraigBartlett: ok

<question> : about the jungle movie...

CraigBartlett : (jungle noises)
CraigBartlett : monkeys screaming
<question> : Stella screaming

CraigBartlett : MILES!!

<question> : was it gonna be like a conclusion for everything? like were arnold and helga

gonna be together, and arnold finds his parents, etc?

CraigBartlett: Well, right, i was trying to wrap it all up, yes.

CraigBartlett: just like in the first movie, the Neighborhood, i was trying to wrap up what

the series meant to us.

CraigBartlett: actually, now when I see the Neighborhood i realise

CraigBartlett: that it was about the end of the series, and all of us losing it.

CraigBartlett: losing the place, I mean.

<question> : I would just like to thank you,sir:)

CraigBartlett : thanks, dude! CraigBartlett : kind words

<question> : I felt bad 4 poor stella in The Journal, I mean giving birth is bad enough, but

that boys head....(shudders)

CraigBartlett: ves. sad. very sad. but also kinda beautiful

CraigBartlett: the lang music "Groove Remote" CraigBartlett: is a favorite theme from the show

CraigBartlett: and you all know it

CraigBartlett: we did a huge orchestral version for the movie CraigBartlett: and it wa all those things: sad, wistful, beautiful

<question> : calm down, slow down,
CraigBartlett : slow down, peeps

<question> : and what is Sid last name?

CraigBartlett : Sid? Vicious CraigBartlett : just kidding

CraigBartlett: i'll be honest, we never needed to give him one, so we didn't

CraigBartlett: it's the same with many of them.

<question> : yeah what was Arnold's last name gonna be?

<question> : arnold swank

CraigBartlett: swank, right on, Kim

<question> : well Helga had one and arnold didn't

<question> : Craig, could you tell us more about what happened between Helga and

Brainy in The Jungle Movie?

CraigBartlett: helga and Brainy had a great scene CraigBartlett: he did his usual annoying thing,

CraigBartlett: appearing behind her etc

CraigBartlett: but then he helps her in a huge way in act three.

CraigBartlett: he kind of brings her back to life.

CraigBartlett: symbolically

<question> : OOOH! I sense a kiss coming......
CraigBartlett : nah, brainy never gets it from Helga

CraigBartlett: it's all sort of a dream now, lost in the mists of time.

CraigBartlett: Brainy?? (echoes into jungle)

<question> : I'm still holding a question from Darth...

CraigBartlett : darth, go!

<question> : Craig: "The Jazz in the show, did Jim Lang inspire it from Vince Limbardi, like you were inspired by Peanuts? I cant help noticing the parallels"

CraigBartlett : good question!

CraigBartlett: the music was inspired by Vince

CraigBartlett: Guaraldi, I think

CraigBartlett: but Jlm and i thought we should update it to the nineties

CraigBartlett: so we made it jazzy, but more influenced by acid jazz, which was big then.

CraigBartlett: jazz instruments, but over urban beats <question>: I miss the 90s, I'm too old nowadays

CraigBartlett: yeah, the 90s were great. more money going around then

CraigBartlett: this millenium? iffy.

<question> : It certainly made me a fan of smooth jazz.Now I can't help but think of

Hillwood streets at night when I hear a really cool jazz song

CraigBartlett: yes, all of you, go to Jlm's site, knob world

CraigBartlett: and download his tunes!

CraigBartlett: your fave arnold tunes reside at Kim's site tho

CraigBartlett: because I collected my faves CraigBartlett: including invisible hippo!

CraigBartlett: and sent 'em to her. she put 'em up

CraigBartlett: the Thanksgiving show

CraigBartlett: is kind of a little masterpiece musically, methings

CraigBartlett: methinks

CraigBartlett:!

CraigBartlett: the cue when the kids are in Simmons kitchen?

CraigBartlett : drop dead great

CraigBartlett: it's one of my faves, comes from a very personal place

CraigBartlett: odd, when you think that Grandma is celebrating the 4th of July

CraigBartlett: not like my childhood at all CraigBartlett: actually not much of HA! is.

<question> : that episode was a masterpiece. It think it shows how Arnold and Helga

would be cute as a couple in a way, the way they got along

CraigBartlett: yeah, they fight cute in that one

CraigBartlett: anyone grow up with their grandparents in a boarding house?

<question> : Not me.

CraigBartlett: remember the one when Helga tried to rent a room disguised as an art

collector?

CraigBartlett: "the locket."

CraigBartlett: that scene, franny and Dan C. as Grandpa was so funny.

<question> : That Helga's Parrot episode is something else

CraigBartlett: yeah, the parrot.

CraigBartlett: kinda of a horror film. with a horror score

<question> : I can't believe she was gonna kill the parrot with a chainsaw!

CraigBartlett: i know. she's a desperate character.

CraigBartlett: the scene when Bob passes Miriam and helga in the hall, and she's got a

chainsaw?

CraigBartlett: pricelesss.

<question> : Spencer sucked. I hated is nassaly voice

CraigBartlett: poor spencer!

CraigBartlett: his ears are burning.

<question> : Where Arnold's character was in The Journal, Alex Linz was a PERFECT fit.

CraigBartlett: yeah, we barely got to use Alex.

CraigBartlett : he would have been great.

<question> : they're all good though

CraigBartlett: yeah, i'm fond of all 5 arnolds.

<question> : Alex would've been in the jungle movie, right?

CraigBartlett : right.

CraigBartlett: there was even another, in the pilot that played in theaters.

CraigBartlett: before Harriet the spy. CraigBartlett: they're all too old now! <question>: JP Daniels did the pilot

CraigBartlett: very good Cool

CraigBartlett: i'm in touch with Fran, Justin, Jamil

CraigBartlett: and I see Dan at parties

CraigBartlett: and I see the rest of them around town.
CraigBartlett: Jamil's an adult now, and girls: he's a hottie

CraigBartlett: he'd want me to tell you that

CraigBartlett: even more

<question> : tell jamil he's def. got fans ;)

CraigBartlett: i will

<question> : So, are all the kids still acting?

CraigBartlett: mostly

CraigBartlett: Jamil and Justin are always pitching ideas, Justin is producing short films

CraigBartlett: he's a playa

CraigBartlett: not a beach, a player. <question>: What is Helga herself doing?

CraigBartlett: Franny graduated from STanford and is maybe going to do a masters

CraigBartlett: I think.

CraigBartlett: she majored in linguistics,

CraigBartlett : spent time in italy

CraigBartlett: I saw her in an all-italian production of Pinocchio

CraigBartlett: she was the fox

<question> : tell Frannie that we all think she's awesome and good luck with her future

endeavors

CraigBartlett: i will.

<question> : how old is she?

CraigBartlett: franny must be... 21 now i think

<question> : I agree with Stephen, those kids are who I think of when I write fanfiction

CraigBartlett: right, you can hear the characters speak.

CraigBartlett: The kids all "got into" their characters right away,

CraigBartlett: kind of lived them. they influenced the stories a lot, esp. Franny and Justin CraigBartlett: because we'd sit around and laugh about their characters, and ideas would come from that.

<question> : With the interest in making live action versions of popular animated show,would you say yes if a major studio came to you with an offer for HA!?

CraigBartlett: sure.

CraigBartlett: but what about ARnold's head?

CraigBartlett: big casting problem.

<question> : Justin made up "madam fortress mommy" ^_^

CraigBartlett: Justin still drops that one.

CraigBartlett: I kept drawing arnold comics

CraigBartlett: I have a friend there

CraigBartlett: Chris Duffy

CraigBartlett: he's a comix editor for them.

CraigBartlett: i drew a new strip fo rthem called "the dumpsters.

CraigBartlett: It'll be in their next ish i think.

CraigBartlett: I'm working on a graphic novel too.

CraigBartlett: but not the jungle movie.

CraigBartlett: not arnold.

CraigBartlett: It's called "Lower Pixieland."

CraigBartlett: his dad loses his job and moves them to the boonies

CraigBartlett: a crummy apartment, and in his closet...

CraigBartlett: a little green door.

CraigBartlett: which leads to Lower Pixieland. <question>: ohh sort-of like Spirited Away?

CraigBartlett: yeah,

CraigBartlett: but i make fun of Narnia a lot, and some LOTR

CraigBartlett: the thing that i find funny and... old fashioned about Narnia CraigBartlett: is the way the kids all embrace their new identities. Peter's all CraigBartlett: "Oh, King Peter? Wonderful. better get to sword practice"

CraigBartlett: my teenager is less enthusiastic.

<question> : I'd hate to see a guy like Arnie in it though X.X

<question> : GOD why did they make him?
CraigBartlett : What, why did we make Arnie?

CraigBartlett: I thought he was great.

CraigBartlett: Arnie was a joke about when we get really ugly animation back from the studio. We turned that into an ep.

<question> : OH - have a pending question from Deep-voice06

CraigBartlett: okay, go deep voice.

<question> : Craig: Has he made any scripts for sixth season episodes and if so, what were the episodes about?

CraigBartlett: we had a list of ideas for a sixth season, but...

CraigBartlett: I have no idea what they were now, five years later.

CraigBartlett : Gerald's bad haircut

<question> : there are some good fanfic writers who had ideas to that effect...krossfire wrote a good series of ideas on that score

CraigBartlett: yeah, we could simply scan the fanfics.

<question> : Gerald and Phoebe relationship was one, and a whole Brainy ep was also a working concept (I'm trying to remember old chats here)

CraigBartlett: you're right, cool

<question> : i think there was one about peapod kid? and some of the other cahracters who never got much air time

CraigBartlett: oh yeah, the fans were demanding more peapod kid.

CraigBartlett: that would be good, too, since Jamil voiced him, and his grown up voice was okay for him.

<question> : I wouldn't have minded more of Nadine, too.

CraigBartlett: Nadine never got much air time. i liked when she told off Rhonda

CraigBartlett: in "Cool party"

<question> : Sheena never had an ep all to herself, and even Iggy got one

CraigBartlett: Sheena, voiced by Fran

CraigBartlett: listen to her when she says "what happened to the lot?" in Vacant Lot. CraigBartlett: Tim (the mixer) kept speeding her up, and it sounds insanely high-pitched.

<question> : more Nate

<question> : haha, who's nate?

CraigBartlett: who's nate? a classic Sid line

CraigBartlett : let's give it up for sid!! CraigBartlett : i love that little squirt

<question> : Here,here!
CraigBartlett : right on

<question> : I really loved how every single character, even background ones, had a

proper life of their own.

CraigBartlett: that was the idea, and it's important to remember that since Nick gave me

five seasons, that was possible.

CraigBartlett: we finally even got to Iggy. <question>: Is Franny BF named Arnold?

CraigBartlett: i dunno, ask Franny

<question> : Curly's Girl was a great episode

CraigBartlett: yeah, the end, when Curly chases Rhonda down the street cracks me up <question>: I'm neutral on Lila. It was all a big missundertanding started by Helga.

CraigBartlett: yeah, Lila is only unconsciously evil.

<question> : Still, I hate how Lila acts at the end of the Timberly and Arnold episode

CraigBartlett: but didn't you love her song?

CraigBartlett: it's one of my favorites.

<question> : Lila is the Jar Jar Binks of Hey Arnold

CraigBartlett: ha!

CraigBartlett: helga is all about karma.

CraigBartlett: she brings about almost all her troubles.

<question> : and what was Lila doin with Olga anyway?

CraigBartlett: yeah, that Lila/Olga moment...

CraigBartlett: pretty funny. We had a lot of fun with that storyboard

CraigBartlett: also, a great Olga moment "Oh no! Buttercup's gone completely crazy!"

CraigBartlett: that line cracks me up. I still use it around the house

<question> : Craig, would you argree by the end of the show, Arnold was second banana and it was pretty much Helga's show? Cause she pretty much did take over the show

CraigBartlett: helga taking over the show?

CraigBartlett: probably.

CraigBartlett: i admit that it was increasingly hard to come up with arnold eps.

CraigBartlett: helga is just so much more "out there," in your face.

<question> : I have a question... did having helga's mom as an alcoholic cause any trouble when making the show?

CraigBartlett: Miriam the alcoholic?

CraigBartlett: actually, it was like the 500 pound gorilla that no one talked about.

CraigBartlett: in recovery.

CraigBartlett: not exactly nickat nite material...

<question> : Big Bob is fantastic
CraigBartlett : yea, i love big bob.
CraigBartlett : Mo is the funniest guy

CraigBartlett: he and DAn when they looped the fight scene in the movie?

CraigBartlett: one of my fave moments int he studio EVER.

<question> : "You're making me think... I don't like it." Me and my friend guote that a lot.

CraigBartlett: other fave moments in the studio...

CraigBartlett: how bout when we recorded all of "Opera" in one sesh?

CraigBartlett: that was so high and happy for me. the kids just rose to the occasion.

CraigBartlett: each kid got up to the mic and topped the last kid.

CraigBartlett: Curly was last. "I'm so fine..."
