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FEDERATION SQUARE HOSTS A WORLD PARTY THIS NEW YEARS EVE

Getting to Federation Square on Public Transport is simple. Catch a train to Flinders Street Station, or any tram route into the City.

The City skyline will burst into a rainbow of colour and sound with a special family fireworks display at 9.15pm. Best viewing areas for the 9.15pm fireworks are Alexandra Gardens, Birrarung Marr, NewQuay & Waterfront City Docklands. The midnight fireworks spectacular can be seen at any one of the six entertainment venues.

On the night, the best way to travel into the City will be by public transport.
