

Standardized Dress Attire is required for all Calallen Primary and Intermediate School students (including Pre-K). Students will have a choice of four solid colored (no logo) style polo shirts or a spirit shirt in short or long sleeve. The four color choices are White, Blue, Gray, and Maroon. There will be three choices of slacks: Navy Blue, Khaki and Blue Jeans.

Our goal at all of the primary and intermediate campuses is not to inconvenience parents/guardians at home or at work during the school day, therefore parents/guardians may assist the school by making sure that their child is wearing the required clothing before he/she leaves home everyday. When the child arrives at school and the dress code violation requires a change of clothing to be corrected, the following procedures will be followed:

1. Students who are not in dress code will have an opportunity to call their parents prior to the beginning of $1^{\text {st }}$ period to bring them a change of clothing.
2. If the dress code violation cannot be corrected by second period or the violation occurs after the start of $1^{\text {st }}$ period, the student will be placed in Lunch D-Hall that school day.
3. Persistent dress code violations may lead to severe disciplinary consequences.

## DRESS CODE ADDENDUM

## PANTS:

Standardized Dress, logo free, navy blue slacks, khaki slacks, or jeans must be worn. Slacks and jeans need to be size appropriate that fit at the waist and the crotch. Slacks and jeans must be hemmed (not frayed, slit at the seams, have holes or tears). Girls may wear Capri pants as long as they fit the standardized dress policy.

## SHORTS:

Standardized Dress, logo free, navy blue shorts, khaki shorts, and jean shorts that are no shorter than a dollar bill width from the top of the kneecap may be worn. Shorts which are too tight or which allow underclothing to show are not permitted.

NOT PERMITTED:

Slits/tears on legs of pants
Bell bottoms
Bagging, sagging, oversized
lace up/button flies
tight fitting
hip huggers
frayed pant leGs
stretch, corduroy, pants/shorts
cargo pants/shorts

## BELTS:

Belts are optional.

## SHIRTS:

Short or long sleeve knit, button down, "polo" style shirts w/ a collar and logo free. Must be solid white, blue, gray, or maroon. Shirttails must be longer than the waistline and should be tucked in. No DENIM.

## TURTLENECKS and LONG SLEEVE under SHIRTS:

- May be worn under the required uniform shirt if:

1. Solid white, blue, gray, or maroon.
2. Logo free.

## SPIRIT SHIRTS:

May be Calallen or Campus Spirit shirts that promote Calallen pride. Spirit shirts may be worn any day of the week and must follow the school colors of white, blue, gray, or maroon. Shirtails must be longer than the waistline and should be tucked in.

## * During the 2006-2007 school year only and only on Fridays, students will be allowed to wear spirit shirts in colors other than the colors required in the standardized dress policy. Monday through Thursday, standardized dress attire is required for all Calallen Primary and Intermediate School students (including Pre-K). Students will have a choice of four solid colored (no logo) style polo shirts or a spirit shirt in short or long sleeve. The four color choices are white, blue, gray and maroon. There will be three choices of slacks: navy blue, khaki and blue jeans.

## SKIRTS/JUMPERS:

Must be logo free and blue, khaki, or denim. Cargo-style pockets are not allowed. Must be no shorter than 3 inches from the top of the kneecap. STRETCH material or tight fitting skirts that allow undergarments to show are NOT allowed.
Shorts must be worn under all skirts or jumpers to cover undergarments.

## SWEATERS / COATS / WINDBREAKERS/SWEATSHIRTS:

Intermediate students will be given the option to wear sweaters or coats of their choice as long as the sweaters or coats are within the Student Code of Conduct guidelines. No inappropriate logo designs and /or advertisements will be permitted. Sweatshirts must be solid white, blue, gray, maroon, or Calallen spirit sweatshirt.

* Outerwear must be of appropriate size, not oversized or baggy.
* Outerwear may not be worn around the waist or hanging off the shoulders.
* Sweatshirts with zippers and buttons are allowed, but must be kept unzipped and unbuttoned at all times.


## SHOES:

Shoes must be worn at all times. Backless shoes or sandals are NOT permitted. Shoes, designed to be worn with shoelaces, must be laced appropriately. Steel-toed boots are not allowed. No heelys (shoes with wheels) will be allowed. Platforms are discouraged. For safety reasons, strapless shoes or shoes with high heels are not appropriate during Physical Education class tennis shoes are recommended.

## HAIR:

* Hair must be neat, clean, and well groomed at all times.
* Completely shaved or partially shaved heads (shaved underneath and long on top) are not allowed.
* Extremely dyed hair, painted/ unnatural hair color, designs or insignias are not permitted.
* Hair may not cover the eyes or hang in front of the face.
* Dreadlocks and distracting braids are not permitted.


## EARRINGS/MAKE UP/BODY ART:

* A maximum of 2 earrings may be worn only by female students and only in the ear lobe itself.
* No make-up is permitted.
* Body/face glitter is not permitted.
* Stickers or tattoos on the face or body are not permitted.
* Cosmetic contact lenses are not allowed.
* Writing on the skin is not permitted.
* Coloring in of fingernails using markers or any other writing utensil is not permitted.
* Body or face piercing are not permitted.
* Notching of the eyebrows is not permitted.


## UNDERGARMENTS:

* Appropriate undergarments will be worn.
* Colored or patterned bras may not be worn underneath white uniform shirts.
* White, grey, navy blue, or maroon t-shirts may be worn underneath the uniform shirt.


## ACCESSORIES:

* Accessories may not display drugs, drug paraphernalia and/or alcohol, sexual or foul language.
* Hats/hoods/caps/bandannas/sunglasses may not be worn in the building.
* Chains on wallets are not allowed.
* Bracelets are limited to 2 per wrist area.
* No studded or spiked wrist bracelets, necklaces, or accessories.
* Accessories that distract from the learning environment will be taken away by the teacher and given to an administrator.
