Rev. Dr. Nancy Cocks (Atlantic School of Theology)

ALISON STEWART-PATTERSON LECTURE

Nancy Cocks is a Presbyterian minister who has served congregations in Ontario and BC. She developed an interest in storytelling in ministry while working with children in her congregations. Her research with children and parents is published in Growing up with God: Using Stories to Explore a Child's Life and Faith (Novalis /Wild Goose 2003). After 10 years at Vancouver School of Theology, she took up a post in Scotland with The Iona Community, working in its ministry of hospitality on Iona. Her new book, Invisible We See You: Reading between the lines at Iona Abbey (Novalis 2006), explores insights into worship, hospitality and Celtic spirituality. She currently serves as Associate Professor of Pastoral Theology at Atlantic School of Theology.



Rev. Dr. Paul Scott Wilson (Emmanuel College, Toronto School of Theology)

Paul Scott Wilson is Professor of Homiletics at Emmanuel College where he has taught since 1981. He is past president of the Academy of Homiletics and leads workshops, preaches and lectures widely in the United States, Canada and Europe. He has written numerous books on the subject of preaching. He is an ordained minister in the United Church of Canada, as is his wife, whom he assists in an honorary ministry at St. Stephen's-on-the-Hill United Church in Mississauga, where he works with the adult church school, the youth group and assisting in worship.



The Rev. Dr. Victor Shepherd (Tyndale Seminary)

Victor Shepherd is Professor of Systematic and Historical Theology at Tyndale Seminary. He has taught at Memorial University of Newfoundland, the Toronto School of Theology, and McMaster University. Currently he is also Professor Ordinarius at the University of Oxford, as well as Adjunct Professor at Trinity College and Wycliffe College, University of Toronto. Dr. Shepherd is the author of several books, including *Seasons of Grace, Making Sense of Christian Faith* and *Witnesses to the Word,* and of numerous articles. He has addressed learned societies in Canada and abroad, including the North American Calvin Studies Society, and has been invited to the International Calvin Studies Colloquium. Dr. Shepherd is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church of Canada and has served pastorates in New Brunswick and Ontario.



The Rev. Dr. Stanley Walters (Tyndale University College)

Stanley Walters is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church in Canada, formerly Professor of Old Testament at Knox College (for 16 years) and minister of Rosedale Presbyterian Church in Toronto (for 9 years). Currently he is visiting Professor of Religious Studies at Tyndale University College, Toronto.
