Agreement for Use Duck Samford Fields 4 – 7

The City of Auburn Parks and Recreation Department will allow _____ to use the baseball fields at Duck Samford

Fields 4-7 if the following criteria are met:

- 1. Team practicing must be an “Auburn” team – 80% of the players must be Auburn residents.**
- 2. Team must carry \$1 million liability insurance and present proof of this at the time of application. Listed on the policy will be the head coach, assistant coaches and players. In the event that a team acquires a new head coach this application must be resubmitted.**
- 3. Head coach must fill out an athletic facility application at least 1 week (5 working days) before the first practice and all terms of that application and the policies attached must be met, including fees for lights, field preparation and staff.**
- 4. Practices may be scheduled during the months of March, April, May, August, September, October, November only and for 3 practices per application.**

Policy for use of Parks & Recreation athletic facilities by outside groups/teams

1. No tournaments April 1 – August 1 (baseball/softball fields)
2. No games June 1 – August 1 (baseball/softball fields)
3. Maximum of 3 games/day on any field (baseball/softball)
4. All athletic fields are closed for the months of December and January.
5. Soccer fields are limited to one outside tournament /season (Sept – Nov and Mar - May)
6. Final decisions on field conditions/cancellations will be made by City of Auburn personnel with renter
7. Field modifications and preparations will be performed by City of Auburn personnel. Minor touch-up work may be performed by renter with the consent of the field supervisor.
8. \$1 million liability policy is required for tournaments and proof presented at time of application
9. Only Auburn teams (80% Auburn players) are eligible to use facility or rent for tournaments
10. No equipment is furnished with facility (i.e. coolers, tables, helmet racks)
11. Auburn Soccer Complex may only be used for soccer games
12. Vendor areas must be approved prior to event. No grills inside the fences at Duck Samford 4 –7 or Auburn Soccer Complex. No tents on grassed areas.
13. \$250 deposit required at time of application for tournaments. The deposit will be refunded after the event providing no damages or repair costs are necessary.
14. Applications must be completed at least 2 weeks (10 working days) in advance for a 1 day tournament, 3 weeks (15 working days) in advance for a 2 day tournament, and 1 week (5 working days) in advance for single or double header games.
15. \$50/field for lining/field prep
\$20/hr/worker
\$25/hr lights
16. Times for use must be set prior to event. There will be a 30 minute mercy time and then lights will be turned off and/or gates locked.
