Career

- In 2005, best finish was a tie for sixth at the BMO Financial Group Canadian Women's Open.
- In 2004, best finish was seventh place at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi; tied her career-low 65 during the third round of the Welch's/Fry's Championship, where she tied for 18th; recorded the first hole-in-one of her LPGA career during the final round of the Mizuno Classic.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for sixth at the Jamie Farr Kroger Classic Presented by ALLTEL; posted a 3-0-1 record to help lead the European Team to victory in The Solheim Cup.
- In 2002, won her second LPGA title at the Asahi Ryokuken International Championship at Mount Vintage, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings; successfully defended her Hyundai Team Matches title with teammate Lorie Kane.
- In 2001, tied for second at the Nabisco Championship to mark her best finish ever in a major championship; matched her career-low 65 during the final round of the LPGA Corning Classic; paired with Lorie Kane to win the Hyundai Team Matches.
- In 2000, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the ShopRite LPGA Classic after firing three rounds in the 60s; a member of the victorious European Solheim Cup Team in her homeland of Scotland, where she posted a 3-1 record; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings at the ShopRite LPGA Classic; tied her career-low 65 during the second round of the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic.
- In 1999, finished second at the Australian Ladies Masters; tied for second at the State Farm Rail Classic, where she tied her career-low 65 during the first round; also shot 65 during the final round of the Standard Register PING.
- In 1998, best finish was fourth place at the Weetabix Women's British Open; tied for fourth at the City of Hope Myrtle Beach Classic; recorded a career-low 65 during the third round of the LPGA Corning Classic; finished second to Se Ri Pak in the Rolex Rookie of the Year race.
- In 1997, qualified for the Tour by tying for 21st at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1998 LPGA season.
- In 1996, turned professional.

Amateur

Moodie captured the 1992 Scottish Ladies title and was a member of the Great Britain and Ireland Curtis Cup Teams in 1994 and 1996. She participated in the World Cup Team Championship from 1995-96. As a competitor on the San Jose State University golf team, she earned First-Team All-American honors from 1994-97. She was the winner of 12 collegiate tournaments and posted the lowest scoring average on her team from 1996-97.
