## III. System Update

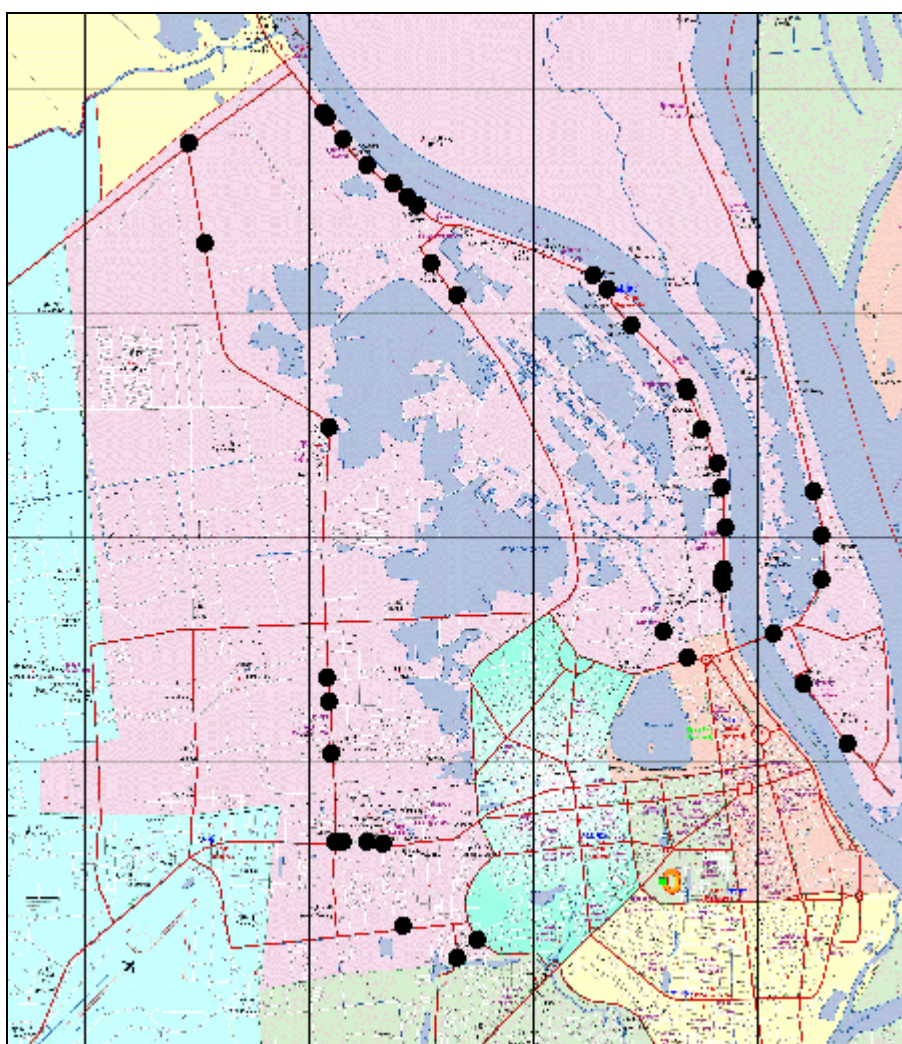
### Introduction of GPS

From July 2006, The Global Positioning System (GPS) devices have been introduced to the traffic police in Russei Keo District in Phnom Penh. The GPS coordinates allow us now to exactly locate accidents, using GIS data.

GPS devices will from now be progressively introduced to other districts of Phnom Penh and provinces crossed by major national roads.

On the medium term, this will enable RTAVIS to identify blackspots of the Cambodian Road System.

The following chart shows the locations of road traffic accidents in Russei Keo district from July to November.

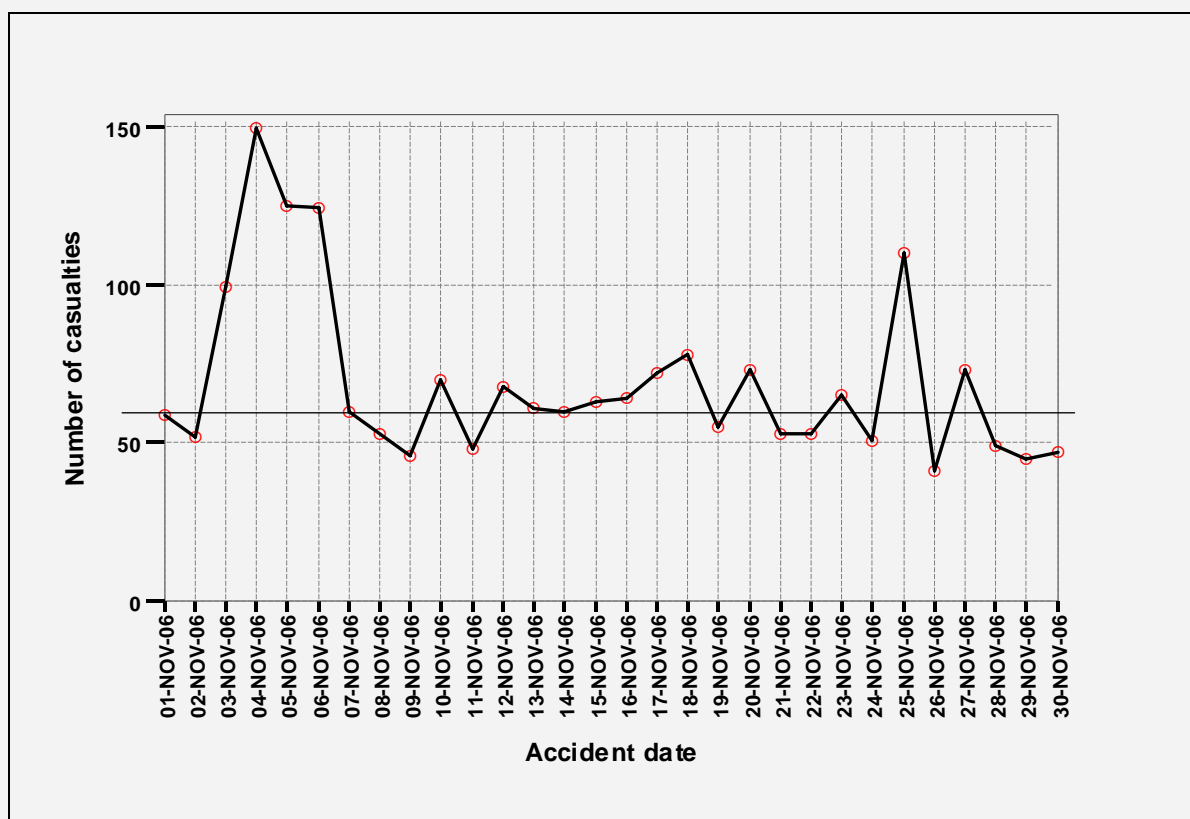

### IV. Executive Summary

Key findings for the month of **November 2006** are the following:

- A provisional number of **2,066 casualties** were reported by the participating hospitals, health centres, private clinics and traffic police departments in the 24 reporting provinces. Among them, **565 were severely injured and 91 died**.
- **In Phnom Penh, 568** casualties were reported, corresponding to a **7% increase compared to November 2005**.
- **43%** of casualties suffered from head injuries.
- **3%** of motorbike casualties wearing a helmet.
- **38%** of casualties injured in motorbike-motorbike collisions and **19%** injured in motorbike-4wheeler collisions.
- Other ratios are similar to the ones from previous months:
  - **72%** of casualties were males.
  - **74%** of casualties were motorbikes riders (driver or passenger) and **8%** were pedestrians.
  - **26%** of casualties were farmers and **23%** were students:
- **Highest daily numbers of casualties were reported during the Water Festival period** ( 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>), with a peak of 150 casualties on the 4<sup>th</sup> of November, corresponding to 2 times higher than the daily average of the month.
