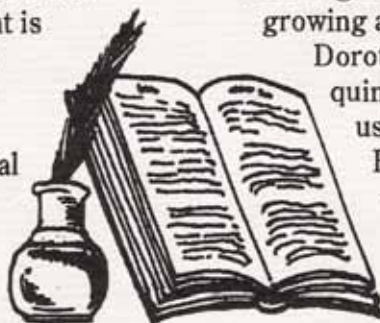


# DOROTHY GOODBODY STORIES FOUND AFTER 40 YEARS

**A** bright Spring morning in St. Owen Street, Hereford and excitement is running high at the Wye Valley Brewery. With good reason. Having launched a new range of beers and ales on the National Market - Dorothy Goodbody's Seasonal Ales - manuscripts telling the story of Dorothy's eventful village life have been discovered. Set in the early 1950's they depict a time of innocence and purity centred around the charming Herefordshire community of Dormington.



Dormington being one of the prime hop growing areas of England encouraged Dorothy to develop a series of quintessentially English Ales using only the finest local Fuggles and Golding hops - a tradition that is now continued by the Wye Valley Brewery with its brewing of the Seasonal Ales.

"It is a remarkable discovery" said proprietor Peter Amor. "Thrilled is the only word possible to describe my feelings. That the stories should so accurately express our sentiments to produce Beers and Ales of quality and purity is astonishing".

The documents were found by chance when Mr. Amor recently attended a country house sale of furniture in Dormington where he discovered them in the drawers of Dorothy's younger sister Elizabeth.

It transpires that Dorothy was the eldest daughter of one Sam Goodbody, a well known and respected Hop grower in the Dormington area. She developed her interest in brewing when she began courting the head brewer at the local brewery.

Derek Kent, Marketing Director for Wye Valley Brewery - an Irishman by birth and descent said, "The stories are very reminiscent of Irish tales of that time - you can almost taste the flavour of the ales that have permeated into the magic of the story telling".

To celebrate this wonderful discovery and the launch of Dorothy Goodbody's Seasonal Ales, the stories are to be published monthly.

On tap at the moment is the GOLDEN SUMMERTIME ALE; pale golden in colour with a full Fuggles and Golding hop flavour. At 4.2 vol it is light and refreshing, the epitome of an English Summer Ale.
