Vancouver Art Gallery presents Massive Change: Visionaries

Featuring global visionary Alvin Toffler, prominent journalist Charlie Rose and world-renowned designer Bruce Mau

Vancouver, BC –On October 15 and 16, the Vancouver Art Gallery will host *Massive Change: Visionaries,* a special event in conjunction with the Gallery's upcoming exhibition *Massive Change: The Future of Global Design* that brings together some of today's most innovative thinkers in a series of conversations with world-renowned designer Bruce Mau and Emmy awardwinning journalist Charlie Rose.

To launch the event, **Alvin Toffler**, author of the classic books *Future Shock* and *The Third Wave*, will deliver a keynote address titled *Leadership in the Third Wave Economy* on Friday, October 15 (7pm) at the Sheraton Vancouver Wall Centre Hotel. This will be followed by a day of discussion and debate moderated by **Bruce Mau** and **Charlie Rose** on Saturday, October 16 (10am to 5.30pm) at The Vogue Theatre, Vancouver. Participants include **Dean Kamen**, inventor, scientist, entrepreneur; **Janine Benyus**, leading thinker in innovative nature-based technology; **Bill Buxton**, techno-humanist; **Hazel Henderson**, futurist and sustainable development visionary; **James Korris**, military analyst/ Hollywood hybridist; **Esther Dyson**, cyber-ethicist; **Jaime Lerner**, architect and revolutionary urban planner; **John Todd**, designer of Eco Machines; **Gwynne Dyer**, journalist on war and international affairs; and, **Andrew Zolli**, forecaster and design strategist.

"I am proud that the Gallery is able to present such a distinguished roster of global visionaries as part of our major exhibition *Massive Change*," commented Kathleen Bartels, Director, Vancouver Art Gallery. "With designer Bruce Mau and journalist Charlie Rose leading the conversations, *Visionaries* will be a lively, engaging, and thought-provoking event".

Massive Change: Visionaries will be held in conjunction with Massive Change: The Future of Global Design, a groundbreaking exhibition that investigates the capacity, power and promise of design. Massive Change takes a radical look at how rapidly evolving technologies have created the potential for design to affect change on a global scale and how this has placed us at the beginning of a new, unprecedented period of human possibility. Massive Change: The Future of Global Design is a project by Bruce Mau Design and the Institute without Boundaries, commissioned and organized by the Vancouver Art Gallery.
