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Project: Kigamboni Bridge -- Tanzania

Project Profile:

The National Social Security Fund (NSSF) of Tanzania plans to construct a bridge to link Kigamboni Ward and the Dar es Salaam city centre. The government conducted a feasibility study and detailed engineering design for the bridge in 1991 under the financial support of the African Development Bank. The government is currently looking for private investors who will implement this project under a Build Operate and Transfer (BOT) arrangement.

The Kigamboni Bridge is to be 560 meters long with 14 spans of 40 meters each. The construction period is expected to take 3.5 years and the bridge is estimated to cost US\$ 46 million.
