Final Highlights of Enrollment for the Autumn Quarter of 2007

October 10, 2007

Autumn Quarter began on September 19, 2007. An official census for the quarter was conducted as of the close of processing on October 8. The fifteenth day census is the basis for these highlights and the supporting data contained herein.

- An overall increase in enrollment of 1,256 students, compared to Autumn Quarter 2006, was recorded for Autumn Quarter 2007 (2.1%). The Columbus campus increased by 750 to 52,568 (1.4%). The Lima campus increased 126 to 1,340 (10.4%), Mansfield campus increased 89 to 1,553 (6.1%), Marion campus increased 95 to 1,633 (6.2%), Newark campus increased 195 to 2,505 (8.4%), and the Wooster campus increased 1 to 748 (0.1%). [Table 1]
- Increases in undergraduate enrollment (up 1,273 to 46,690; 2.8%) and graduate professional enrollment (up 6 to 3,262; 0.2%) and a decrease in graduate enrollment (down 23 to 10,395; -0.2%) were recorded this guarter. Four sources of total undergraduate enrollment experienced increases: New first-quarter freshmen (up 575 to 9,076; 6.8%), transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 125 to 1,664; 8.1%), continuing students (up 604 to 32,944; 1.9%), and former students (up 36 to 1,551; 2.4%). The source category that experienced a decrease was transfer students above rank 2 (down 67 to 1,455; -4.4%). At the extended campuses as a whole, two source categories recorded an increase: New first-quarter freshmen (up 627 to 2,966; 26.8%) and former students (up 54 to 414; 15.0%). The remaining three categories saw decreases: transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (down 43 to 151; -22.2%), transfer students above Rank 2 (down 69 to 383; -15.3%), and continuing students (down 26 to 3,567; -0.7%). Three sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus experienced increases from Autumn Quarter 2006: Transfer students in Ranks 1 and 2 (up 168 to 1,513; 12.5%), transfer students above Rank 2 (up 2 to 1,072; 0.2%), and continuing students (up 630 to 29,377; 2.2%). The remaining two sources of undergraduate enrollment at the Columbus campus: New first-quarter freshmen (down 52 to 6,110; -0.8%) and former students (down 18 to 1,137; -1.6%) experienced decreases. The enrollment of graduate students at Columbus campus for Autumn Quarter 2007 increased from Autumn Quarter 2006 (up 14 to 10,097; 0.1%) while the enrollment of graduate students at the extended campuses decreased (down 37 to 298; -11.0%). Overall, new graduate students (down 20 to 2,452; -0.8%) and former graduate students (down 19 to 495; -3.7%) were down while continuing graduate students (up 16 to 7,448; 0.2%) were up. In total, enrollment of graduate students was down 23 to 10,395 (-0.2%) while enrollment of graduate professional students was up 6 to 3,262 (0.2%). [Table 2]

- Two undergraduate curricular academic programs saw an increase in enrollment from Autumn Quarter 2006 in excess of ten percent. They are: Arts and Sciences, General (up 151 to 1,259; 13.6%) and Undergraduate Student Academic Services (up 167 to 392; 74.2%). One undergraduate curricular programs saw a decrease in excess of ten percent: Arts and Sciences, Unknown (down 10 to 33; -23.3%). Graduate level programs that recorded changes (positive or negative) in excess of ten percent are: Biological Sciences (down 66 to 386; -14.6%), Architecture (up 26 to 206; 14.4%), Food, Agriculture, and Environmental Sciences (up 81 to 412; 24.5%), Nursing (up 29 to 306; 10.5%), Pharmacy (up 10 to 97; 11.5%), Public Health (up 41 to 325; 14.4%), Optometry (up 4 to 16; 33.3%) and Veterinary medicine (down 13 to 104; -11.1%). - Credits generated by full-time undergraduates increased at Columbus (up 12,467 to 572,715; 2.2%) and at the extended campuses as a whole (up 7,333 to 94,218; 8.4%). The net result was a total increase of 19,800 to 666,933 (3.1%) from Autumn Quarter 2006. Credits generated by part-time undergraduates at Columbus decreased 1.6% (down 378 to 23,659) and the extended campuses increased as a whole 548 to 9,832; (5.9%). The net result was an increase of 170 to 33,491 (0.5%). An increase of 19,970 to 700,424 (2.9%) in credits generated by both full-time and part-time undergraduates for the entire university was reported. As credit hours attempted at the undergraduate level throughout the university increased, so did credits per student (up 0.02 to 15.00; 0.1%). At the graduate level, there was an overall increase in credits (up 574 to 122,398; 0.5%). The Columbus campus reported an increase of credits generated by graduate students (up 1,305 to 119,351; 1.1%) while the extended campuses as a whole reported a decrease of 731 to 3,047 (-19.3%). Graduate professional headcounts were up 6 to 3,262 (0.2%) while both credits (down 474 to 63,640; -0.7%) and credits per student (down 0.18 to 19.51; -0.9%) decreased. Undergraduate FTE increased from 45,364 to 46,695. Graduate professional FTE decreased from 4,274 to 4,243. Graduate FTE increased from 8,122 to 8,160. [Table 4]
- For the total university, the following county recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Autumn Quarter 2006: Brown (up 40.0%). At Columbus, the following counties recorded enrollment changes in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative): Brown (up 33.3%) and Holmes (up 25.8%). [Table 5 and Table 6]
- For the total university, the states and territories with enrollment that increased or decreased in excess of twenty percent (positive or negative) from Autumn Quarter 2006 were: Minnesota (up 25.2%), Washington (up 35.6%), New Hampshire (up 41.2%), Maine (up 27.3%), Nevada (up 25.0%), Hawaii (up 29.4%), Mississippi (up 22.2%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 25.0%), Military Addresses (down 100.0%), Palau Island (down 100.0%), and the Virgin Islands (down 100.0%). At Columbus, the states and territories with enrollment that changed in excess of twenty percent from last Autumn Quarter are: Minnesota (up 25.2%), Washington (up 33.9%), New Hampshire (up 41.2%), Maine (up 22.7%), Nevada (up 25.0%), Hawaii (up 29.4%), Mississippi (up 22.2%), South Dakota (up 33.3%), Vermont (down 25.0%), Military Addresses (down 100.0%), Palau Island (down 100.0%), and the Virgin Islands (down 100.0%). - Of the twenty-five countries with the largest representation of students enrolled at The Ohio State University, Indonesia (down 28.8%), Pakistan (up 25.0%), Italy (up 35.3%), Brazil (down 26.7%), United Arab Emirates (up 61.5%), and Romania (down 20.8%) recorded changes in enrollment in excess of twenty percent from Autumn Quarter 2006. People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, India, Taiwan, Japan, and Canada recorded enrollment of 100 or more students in Autumn Quarter 2007. [Table 9]
- On the Columbus campus, Continuing Education had an international enrollment of 12.8 percent. The undergraduate curricular academic program with international student enrollment in excess of five percent was Business (6.9%). Undergraduate international enrollment was 1,073 for the total university and 1,065 on the Columbus campus. On Columbus campus, forty percent or more of the graduate students in Biological Sciences (47.2%), Mathematical and Physical Sciences (45.4%), Engineering (57.1%), Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (43.9%), and Pharmacy (55.7%) were international students. [Table 10 and 12]
- At the Undergraduate level, enrollment of Ohio residents (up 1,069 to 42,156; 2.6%) and not-Ohio residents (up 204 to 4,534; 4.7%) increased. Graduate enrollment of Ohio residents decreased (down 69 to 5,966; -1.1%) while enrollment of not-Ohio residents increased (up 46 to 4,429; 1.0%). An increase was recorded in Graduate Professional enrollment among Ohio residents (up 29 to 2,927; 1.0%) while not-Ohio residents decreased (down 23 to 335; -6.4%). [Table 14]
- Autumn 2007 had a record high enrollment of 2,896 for Asian or Pacific Islander students and a record high enrollment of 1,442 for Hispanic students. A record high of 29,752 total female students was reached for the entire university.
