a) <u>2007 World Championships</u> (1 place)

The World Champion will qualify. If the host nation CHN is World Champion, the second-ranked team at the World Championship concerned qualifies

b) <u>Host nation</u> (1 place)

The host nation of the Olympic Games shall be automatically qualified

c) Continental Qualifications (4 places)

One team shall be qualified from each of the four continental federations (on the occasion of the Continental Championship concerned):

- Africa
- Asia
- Europe
- Pan-America

In the event that the 2007 World Champion (or the host nation) also wins the Continental Championship, the second-ranked team of the continental championship concerned will qualify.

The events to be staged at continental qualification events are noted under the qualifying timeline.

d) <u>IHF Qualifying Tournaments</u> (6 places)

The remaining six (6) teams are established as follows:

Three (3) tournaments (for men and women each) with four (4) teams participating in each (=12 teams). Participants:

- Six (6) teams ranked 2nd to 7th at the 2007 World Championship (excluding those teams already qualified through continental qualification or as host nation)
- The highest ranked team from each continental qualification event (excluding those teams already qualified)
 - 1 x Africa
 - 1 x Asia
 - 1 x Europe
 - 1 x Pan-America
- 1 x*
- 1 x* #

If Oceania is ranked between places 8-12 at the 2007 World Championship, it will be allocated this second place otherwise 'owned' by the continent which ranked second at the 2007 World Championship.

The first- and second-ranked teams from each of these three tournaments will qualify for the Olympic Games.
