



A new standard governing the colour coding of transportable gas cylinders is coming into force across Europe. The new standard, EN1089-3, will ensure consistency of colour coding, helping to improve safety standards across the industry.

Air Products have many hundreds of thousands of cylinders in the UK, and the repainting exercise will take a number of years to complete, therefore, you may have cylinders delivered bearing both the old and new colours. The cylinder label, details of which are given in this leaflet, will be vital to understanding the product contained.

Please ensure that this information is made available to anyone in your organisation who handles or uses industrial gas cylinders.


