Units Issued Permits**



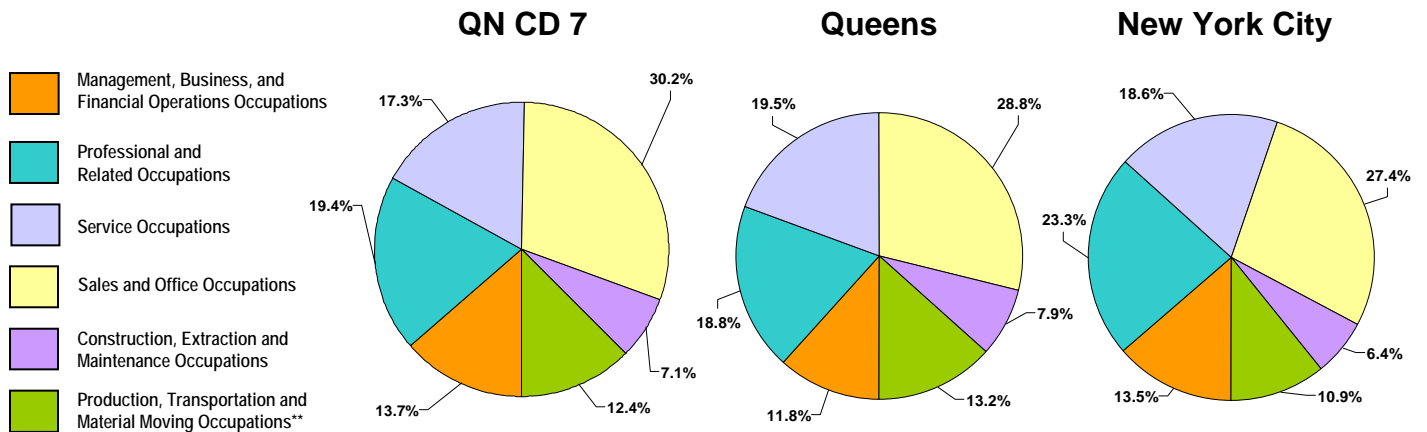

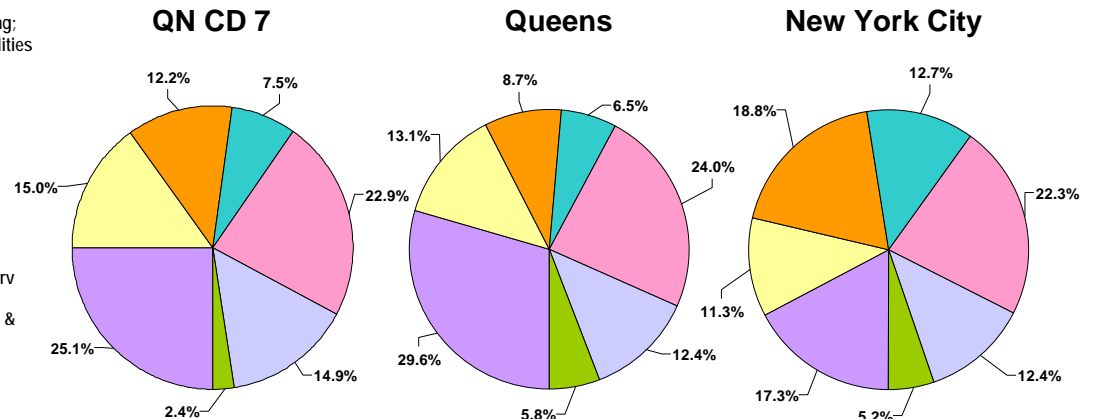

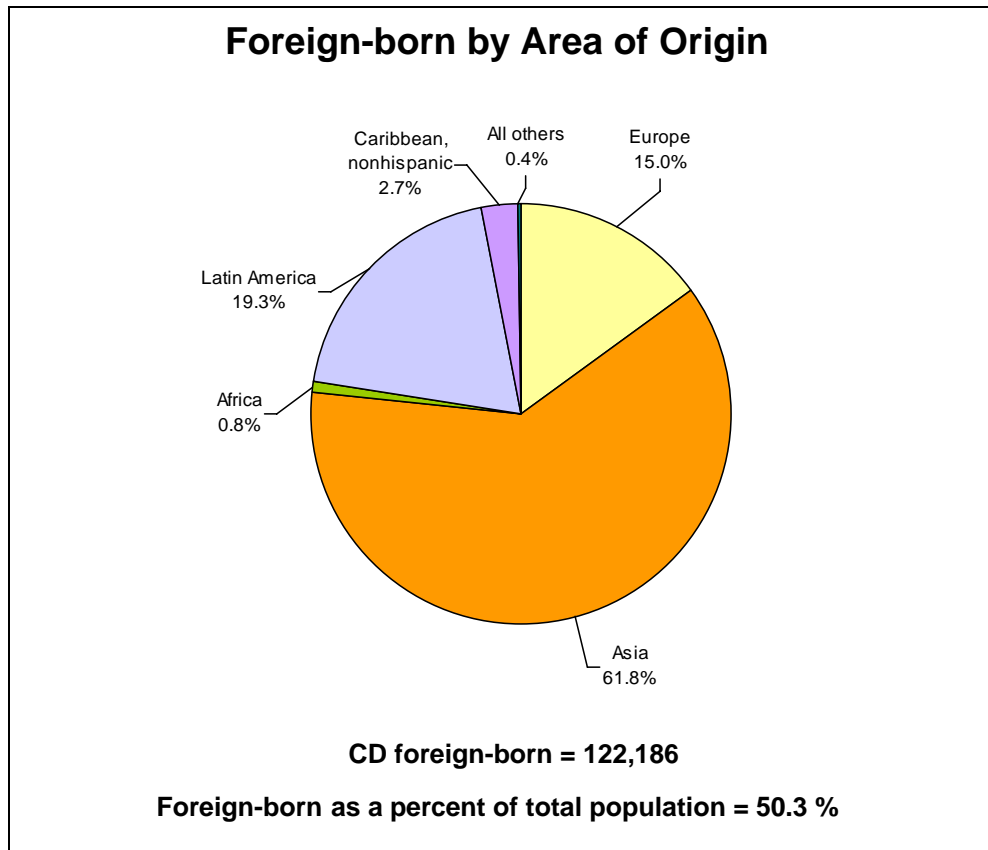
