2. Structure and Organization of the Department

The Department of Turkish Language and Literature started its program in the 1999-2000 Academic Year. The aim of the department is to equip the students with the skills to carry out research in academic and professional levels. The curriculum is designed to give students scholarly background and give guidance to generate original works in their areas.

Turkish language is used in a very wide range of geographical regions of the world and has a long historical background. Because of these facts, it is also important to study modern Turkic dialects. The curriculum is designed to serve this purpose as well. The program emphasizes on the use of computers in research and literary writing. It is the general policy that all graduates of Başkent University are proficient in English. Students are encouraged to learn foreign languages other than English so that they can become familiar with the basic information technologies and use them in accordance with the requirements of the information age, which will bring them a great deal of advantage in their professional life. Students are also provided with the opportunity to take elective courses from other departments.

The full-time academic staff of the program consist of 1 professor, 1 associate professor, 4 assistant professor and 2 instructors. The total number of students in four grades is 83.

3. Facilities of the Department

4. The Degree Programs and Duration of the Studies

Students who complete the Turkish Language and Literature Program receive an undergraduate degree. The undergraduate program extends over 4 academic years comprising 8 semesters.

5. Teaching and Learning Methods

Classes are held on the basis a teaching method that puts the student at the centre of all activities. Maximum use is made of modern educational aids and materials. The presentation and discussion of the issues handled is supported by audio-visual materials. In the evaluation of student performance, research projects and various presentations are also taken into consideration, along with written and oral exams.

B. Degree Structure

1. Qualifications

Turkish Language and Literature Program centres on Turkish language and literature at undergraduate level. The program extends over 4 academic years (8 semesters, 14 weeks). Each student is required to take at least 4 elective courses within the department. Besides, students can take courses with or without credit from the BÜDAM (Başkent University Center for Language Studies) at the University if they want to learn different foreign languages. Also, students have the opportunity to receive courses on various branches of art from the Faculty Fine Arts on the basis of their ability and interest. Students are required to complete 240 ECTS credits to be able to graduate from the program.
