

CURRENT LIST OF ACCESSIBLE SCHOOLS

Many schools and education programs operated by the Department of Education (D.O.E.) are currently accessible to students and others who have mobility impairments. What follows is a list of accessible schools. The most recently constructed buildings were designed in accord with the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG). These meet the highest standard of accessibility. All schools/programs located in such buildings are fully accessible. Many other schools are functionally accessible, albeit not to ADAAG standards. On the charts beginning on the next page, functionally accessible schools, including those in buildings that meet ADAAG standards, are indicated with an "F." More than one administrative school may be located within the same building. In some instances, different schools within the same building can have different accessibility designations if the building, itself, is not fully compliant with ADAAG standards.

The D.O.E. recognizes that not all persons with disabilities have the same needs and that not all persons who use wheelchairs have the same needs. Thus, no single standard is a guarantee or a minimum for all persons with mobility impairments. Ultimately, what matters is that each student has adequate access and a sense of belonging, whatever his needs and his means of getting around. **As used here, functional accessibility means that a student who uses a wheelchair can, without difficulty, enter the building and access all relevant school programs and services including bathrooms, class-related laboratories, library, lunchroom, auditorium and gymnasium.** Schools listed as functionally accessible include those that have minor technical variances from ADAAG that will not foreseeably affect the ability of students and others to obtain equal and free access. Similarly, the list of functionally accessible schools includes schools that vary from ADAAG standards in ways that may make a difference to the ability of some students to gain easy access to buildings and programs. When making accessibility-driven renovations in a particular building, the D.O.E. and the Chancellor (through the School Construction Authority) will therefore exercise their discretion to make selected other renovations in the same building in order to address variations from ADAAG standards.

Some schools are functionally accessible, but only on the first floor. Such schools are indicated with a "1." A school has this designation only if, among other things, an accessible bathroom is available to those on the first floor. Other schools might be functionally accessible on more than the first floor but not for **all relevant spaces** in the school. Such schools are indicated with a "P." Schools offering no significant degree of accessibility are not listed.

The school buildings of the D.O.E. are configured in a variety of ways, with annexes, mini-schools, transportable units, sites housing several organizations, organizations spanning more than one site, and the like. Therefore, no simple list will convey all of the nuances of the degree to which each school building and school organization is functionally accessible. The list that follows is intended to be as comprehensive and accurate as possible, and to err on the side of understating the array of accessible opportunities rather than overstating them. This list incorporates all changes and updates provided by Regions 1 through 10, District 75 (Citywide Programs) and the School Construction Authority.
