On March 15, 2006, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) published its final rule on the definition of gas gathering lines. This rule completely changes the previous regulations for gas gathering.

Pipelines that were previously considered to be regulated gas gathering may now be exempt. Likewise, other pipelines that were previously considered to be exempt gas gathering will now be regulated.

The new definition depends largely on API RP-80 to define the lines that are "gas gathering", with a few modifications. For those lines that are regulated, there will be 2 levels of compliance requirements.
