# PASS HIGHLIGHTS

## Sydney <> Cairns

### Sydney to Surf Camp

East Coast, here we come... and the first stop is your surf lesson! On the way, there's lots of bush, cool tunes and sometimes a bus-stop. Get off to check out World Heritage Listed Barrington Tops NP and unique activities. We arrive at Mojo's Surf School where you meet the waves for your first surf lesson. You'll be standing up in no time. We spend the night at Mojo's cool Surf Camp. Stay longer if you reckon surfing's your thing!

### Surf Camp to Byron Bay

Get up early if you want more wave action, then it's back on the Pacific Highway, the leg to Byron Bay just takes a few hours. We split off at Ballina, taking the coast road through Lennox Head into Byron Bay. Enjoy! Take a cheap day tour to Nimbin, town of happy hippies (optional).

### Byron Bay to Gold Coast

It's a short stage today. The Gold Coast... 40 kms of golden sands, a land of theme parks, cheap rent luxury high-rise apartments, beautiful people, tanned wrinklies, nearby Hinterlands and great sushi bars. Try it for yourself and see...

### Gold Coast to Brisbane

We pull over to go zorbing (own expense). You + a big hollow plastic ball, add a hill into the mix and... The trip into Brisbane is quick. Brissie is Oz's #3 city and end of the road for today. Get off our bus. Stay a night. Stay longer.

### Brisbane to Noosa

Heading out of Brissie, stay awake for interesting information from your new driver-guide and gaze out the glass to the west for views of the Glasshouse Mountains, remnants of volcanoes from a long time ago. After a while, we turn for the Sunshine Coast and stop in the yuppie holiday spot Noosa.

### Noosa to Rainbow Beach

Back on the bus, we take a few back roads to rejoin the highway north and then branch off to Rainbow Beach, which has awesome coloured sands (hence the name) and guided walks are possible. You can do Fraser Island trips from here with a 10 minute ferry onto the Island (or keep going for next stop Hervey Bay). At Rainbow Beach there's a huge range of adventure activities on offer, from hang-gliding, shark diving to sea-kayaking with dolphins. If you do decide to jump off here, you'll get to be part of some Aboriginal cultural appreciation.

### Rainbow Beach to Hervey Bay

Not so far to get to Hervey Bay, the other point to access the amazing

Fraser Island. Along the way, eyeball the grand old architecture of Maryborough.

### Hervey Bay to Koombit

Now we go inland via Childers almost into the Outback, to our cattle station overnight at Koombit. There's a local payment to cover bush dinner, bunk accomm and brekkie. Don't go to bed before cracking a whip and getting bucked off the mechanical bull!

### Koombit to Sarina

We don't leave the station until the goats are rounded up by horseback (optional extra at own expense), then be part of a real-life mini-deer which is loads of laughs. Stay behind for more or get back on the bus. Rock on to Rocky.

### Sarina to Airlie Beach

We're invited to play bare-foot bowls at Sarina Bowling Club. There's more miles to overcome before our evening arrival into Airlie Beach, access point for the Whitsunday Islands and a not-to-be-missed 2 or 3 day sailing trip (optional) followed by the traditional night on the town. This is Airlie Beach after all!

### Airlie Beach to Townsville (with optional Magnetic Island)

Next stop: city of Townsville for Magnetic Island. Stay aboard or jump bus for 2 or 3 days, take the ferry and relax, try sea kayaking, go for a walk... it's chilled out here. Magnetic Island is the sunniest spot on the QLD coast. (More than 320 sunny days a year!) You'll think you've landed in paradise. Get out for some hikes or try and spot koalas in their natural habitat.

### Townsville to Mission Beach

After Townsville, the mountains grow higher and move in to be closer to the coast. We detour to Mission Beach, where the rainforest meets the sea. This is one great place to stay over. If you're lucky you'll see a Cassowary, these are seriously big birds with attitude.

### Mission Beach to Cairns

An easy afternoon section completes your Oz Ex trip. We head for a guided walk and swim at Babinda Boulders. After arriving in Cairns you have many options to travel to Cape Tribulation, the world's oldest living rainforest. Don't forget the Great Barrier Reef!

**NOTE: Tours operate in both directions. Overnight stops may vary in reverse directions.**

## Kakadu 4WD Safari

### Darwin to Kakadu

Spot crocs (and other wild creatures!) on a cruise along the fresh waters of the Mary River Wetlands. After lunch, discover more about the land and its stories at the Bowali Visitor Centre. The whole of Kakadu is spread out before you at Ubirr Rock, where we spend the afternoon. Tonight we camp in Kakadu National Park.

### Kakadu to Darwin

Jim Jim Falls is our first stop today, and it's a stunner! You'll feel a bit dwarfed by the towering cliffs as we hike to the base of the falls. By now you've probably worked up an appetite for some lunch! This afternoon the spectacular gorge of Twin Falls is experienced onboard a National Park operated boat and along the boardwalk. Unwind for a bit on the sandy banks before we trek back to Darwin.

## Darwin <> Alice Springs

### Darwin to Katherine Gorge

Leaving Darwin, we stop for a break at Adelaide River on the way to Katherine. We spend the whole afternoon at the majestic Katherine Gorge (Nitmiluk). Experience the striking beauty while canoeing or cruising (at own expense) through the gorge itself. Tonight we stay at our permanent camp near Katherine Gorge.

### Katherine Gorge to Tennant Creek

Not far to the south is Mataranka, where you can revive in a sparkling thermal pool surrounded by lush tropical forest. Next stop is the iconic Daly Waters outback hotel, the Territory's oldest pub. After lunch, we continue south to Tennant Creek where we camp overnight at Juno Horse Farm.

### Tennant Creek to Alice Springs

This morning we check out the sacred site of the Devils Marbles, which balance precariously on their rocky perch. A visit to Ti Tree gives you the chance to buy original works of art by Indigenous artists, before crossing over the Tropic of Capricorn to arrive in Alice Springs late in the afternoon.

## 2 day Red Centre Highlights

### Alice Springs - Kings Canyon - Uluru

Kick off your Red Centre Adventure with a drive through James and Waterhouse Ranges and the ancient Hugh and Finke river systems on the way to Kings Canyon. There's a bit of exploring to do here: the

monumental North and South Walls, the Amphitheatre, the Lost City and the lush, inviting Garden of Eden. From here we head for an even more ancient landform, Uluru (Ayers Rock), where we stay overnight in our private campsite.

### Uluru to Alice Springs

Sunrise at Uluru is worth the early start! Take a stroll partway around the base and discover mystifying rock formations and Aboriginal art sites, or climb Uluru if you choose. Be fascinated by the red domes of Kata Tjuta (The Olgas) and their spiritual significance to the Anangu people. Back to Alice Springs after lunch, watching through the window as the rugged desert scenery whizzes by.

## Alice Springs <> Adelaide

### Alice Springs to Kings Canyon & Uluru

Journey deep into the remote Red Centre as we head towards Kings Canyon. There's lots to explore here, and we check out the Amphitheatre, Lost City, the lush and ancient Garden of Eden, and the sheer outcrops of the North and South Walls. After a bite to eat, we'll pass Mt Connor and Curtin Springs cattle station on the way to Uluru. Tonight, you'll be glad to curl up in your swag after dinner as millions of stars fill the sky.

### Uluru and Kata Tjuta

Sunrise over Uluru is magical! It's an early start to catch it. Take a walk around Uluru's base, or climb to the top if you choose. (Anangu traditional owners prefer it if you don't.) Gain a further insight into the land at the Cultural Centre. After lunch, we head to fascinating Kata Tjuta (The Olgas) to hike the Valley of the Winds. A sparkling glass of wine is perfect while the desert sun sets over Uluru. Dinner is a traditional camp oven cook-up back at camp.

### Uluru to Coober Pedy

We get away early this morning as we cross the NT/SA border on the way to Coober Pedy. Time to go underground! Learn about this unique place with a mine tour, including an opal cutting demonstration. If we've got time, try your luck at 'noodling' for opals yourself! Tonight we sleep in an underground bunkhouse.

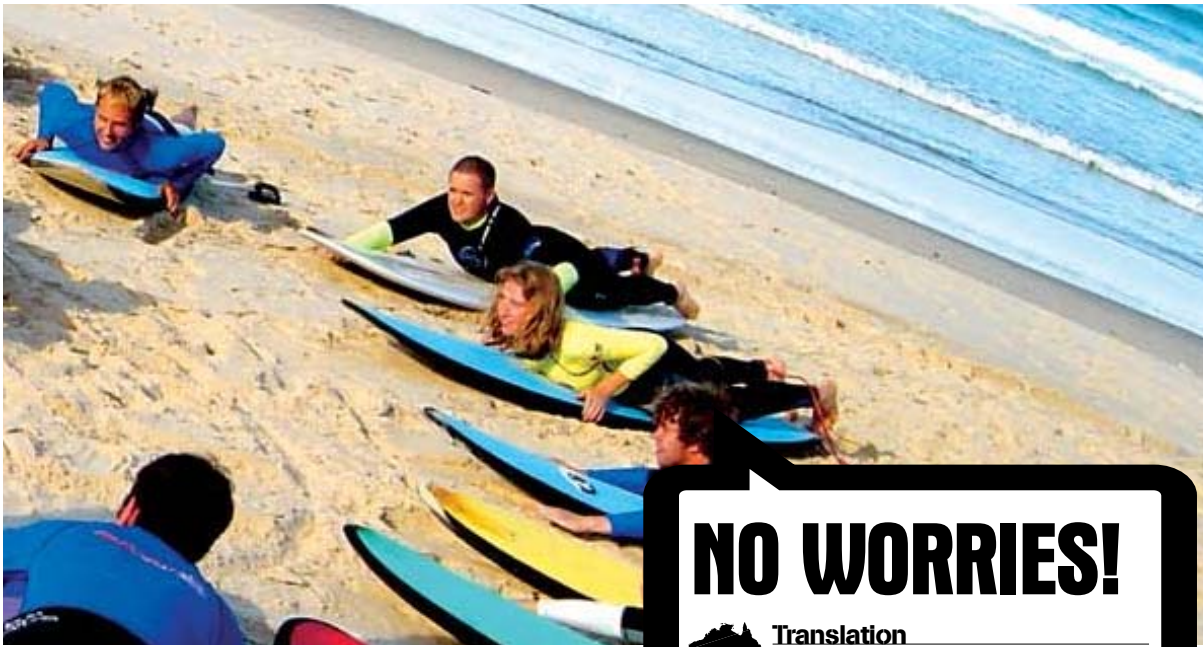
### Coober Pedy to Rawnsley Park

We keep heading south along the Stuart Highway, past the turn-off to 'rocket-launching' town Woomera on the way to lunch at Port Augusta. We reach Rawnsley Park, a sheep station set against the spectacular range of Wilpena Pound, in the late afternoon, and spend the night here in bunkhouse accommodation.

### Wilpena Pound to Parachilna

Challenge yourself this morning as we get an early start to tackle Mt Ohlissen-Bagge, where sweeping views spread out before you. You'll be ready for lunch before we drive through the stunning Parachilna Gorge (weather permitting) on our way to Parachilna. Get ready for tonight's BBQ – it doesn't get more Aussie than this! We stay in dorm accommodation in Parachilna.

### Parachilna to Adelaide

Check out some interesting Aboriginal rock art this morning with a short walk to Yourambulla Caves, before lunch in the quaint historic railway town, Quorn. Ruggedly beautiful Alligator Gorge, renowned for its distinct flora and fauna, is a great place to stretch your legs on an interpretive walk (seasonal). From here, our journey continues through the picturesque Clare Valley before arriving in Adelaide.

### Adelaide <> Melbourne

### Adelaide to Grampians NP

Through the picturesque Adelaide Hills, we cross the mighty Murray River and pass through some little SA country towns on our way to the Grampians NP. Get your legs working this afternoon with hikes at Hollow Mountain and the amazing MacKenzie Falls. We'll be rewarded with breathtaking sunset views from The Balconies and Reeds Lookout. We spend the night in the heart of the Grampians, Halls Gap.

### Grampians NP via the Great Ocean Rd to Princetown

Hiking to the Pinnacle is a challenge, but on the way you'll experience breathtaking views of the national park. Next we head south to the coast and Warrnambool, where you'll have the chance to spot whales (seasonal). There's lots to explore along the famous Great Ocean Road, renowned for its beauty. There's lots to discover before sunset over the Twelve Apostles – gorgeous! Stay overnight in the coastal township of Princetown.

### Princetown to Melbourne

Climb down the Gibson Steps to the beach to get a different angle of the Twelve Apostles, and then we'll spend some time at the Otway Fly, a 25 metre high elevated tree top walk. Continuing on, we pass through the magnificent cool temperate rainforests of the Otway National Park. We'll stop for lunch at the coastal town of Apollo Bay. Hugging the coastline, we pass through Lorne, before our next stop where we'll search for koalas. Check out world famous Bells Beach before a shopping break at surfing town Torquay, home of surf labels

Quiksilver and Rip Curl. With some bargains in your bags, we arrive in Melbourne in the early evening.

### Melbourne <> Sydney

(This section will require a minimum 4 days travelling until 31st March 2007)

### Melbourne to Wilsons Promontory NP and Lakes Entrance

Our adventure starts early, travelling southeast of Melbourne through pastoral South Gippsland to Wilsons Promontory National Park. Walk along gleaming beaches, watch the ocean pound onto the southernmost point of the mainland, hike along amazing granite rock formations and learn about coastal flora and native wildlife. You might even see emus and wombats! In the afternoon we travel to the coastal town of Lakes Entrance. Here, we're at the Gateway to the Gippsland Lakes and Australia's longest beach – Ninety Mile Beach.

### Lakes Entrance Jindabyne via Snowy River Country

This morning we begin our journey into Snowy River Country, taking a break to fly down the 'zip wire' (optional activity at own expense). It's a spectacular drive along Barry Way, before crossing the state border into NSW. In the afternoon, we climb high into the Australian Alps (seasonal Nov-May). An alpine hike (2.5 hour round trip) rewards you with stunning views of the glacial 'Blue Lake' and the top of Mt Kosciuszko (Australia's highest point). During winter, play in the snow at the ski resort of Perisher/Smiggins (optional toboggan hire or snow tube at own expense). Tonight you'll enjoy dinner and overnight dorm accommodation at Lake Jindabyne. Kick back and relax with a sauna, swim or a drink at the bar.

### Jindabyne to Sydney via Canberra

If you're up early there's time for trout fishing in the lake or you could even go water skiing or wake boarding (all at own expense and seasonal). Leaving Jindabyne, we pass through Cooma, learning about the Snowy Hydro-Electric Scheme (one of the most complex integrated water and hydro-electric power schemes in the world!). Next stop is Canberra, Australia's capital city, where the Prime Minister hangs out. We'll check out Parliament House and other city highlights before travelling on to Sydney.

### Big Croc

### Darwin to Mary River

A refreshing start to your day: the waterfalls of Litchfield National Park, followed by the spectacular Mary River Wetlands. Birds aren't the only wildlife abundant around here; keep your eyes out for lurking crocs on our private river cruise! A secluded campsite at Point Stuart Wilderness Lodge is where we'll stay tonight.

### Mary River to Kakadu

Discover ancient Aboriginal rock art at Ubirr, our first stop this morning. Clamber to the top of a rocky lookout for fabulous views over the Nardab floodplain. Next it's on to Maguk (Barramundi Gorge), where a hike is rewarded with a reviving swim in the plunge pools. Tonight we stay at our permanent camp within Kakadu NP.

### Kakadu to Darwin

Get ready for some 4WD action today on our way to Jim Jim Falls! Once we get there, we'll hike to the base of the falls before continuing on to Twin Falls. Feel the beauty of the stunning gorge and powerful falls from the National Park operated boat and boardwalk experience. The impressive scenery will continue to amaze you as we journey back to Darwin in the afternoon.

### Big Rock

### Alice Springs to Kata Tjuta & Uluru

Kick off your adventure on top of a camel! Our first stop is the Outback Camel Farm where you can choose to ride atop one of these desert giants (at own expense). From here it's off to Uluru (Ayers Rock), and a bite to eat. Kata Tjuta will fascinate you, and you might discover some of the secrets of this ancient landform on the Valley of the Winds hike. You'll be mesmerised as the desert sun sets over Uluru, and as the night grows darker, curl up in your swag (Aussie bedroll) under millions of stars.

### Uluru to Kings Canyon

It's an early start this morning, but you'll be rewarded with a glorious Uluru sunrise. Stretch your legs with a walk around Uluru's base, or choose to climb the Rock. You'll deepen your understanding of the land and its stories at the Cultural Centre. After lunch we travel to our permanent campsite at Kings Canyon. You'll fall asleep contented with a delicious camp oven dinner filling your stomach.

### Kings Canyon to Alice Springs

Get your hiking shoes on today as we head out to explore the impressive formations which make up Kings Canyon. You'll be left breathless by the sheer beauty of the Canyon as we trek through the Amphitheatre, the Lost City, the lush and ancient Garden of Eden and the North and South Walls. Lunch is a welcome prospect, before we make our way back to Alice Springs.

### Cairns <> Alice Springs (at own expense)

### Cairns to Hughenden

Travel through the Atherton Tablelands westward to Porcupine Gorge and Hughenden.

### Hughenden to Boulia

Aussie history, a change of landscape, an authentic sheep station and more.

### Boulia to Alice Springs

A long stretch along remote unsealed roads, passing through cattle stations and along the edge of the Simpson Desert before reaching Alice Springs.

### Cairns <> Darwin (at own expense)

### Cairns to Croydon

Say goodbye to the coast and rainforest as we travel west across the Atherton Tablelands and through the Gulf Savannah country. Stay in an authentic outback Aussie pub in Croydon.

### Croydon to Adels Grove

Lawn Hill National Park (Boodjamulla) is today's highlight after travelling along the Burke and Wills Development Road.

### Adels Grove to Cape Crawford

The Gulf Country roads are remote and we pass through the ancient landscape of the Barkly Tablelands, spending the night at Cape Crawford.

### Cape Crawford to Darwin

Meeting up with the Stuart Highway, stop in at Daly Waters Pub before heading through Matranka and Katherine on the way to Darwin.

**Day 1 - Sydney to Surf Camp**
