



Public Service Act 1999

**Order to Establish Old Parliament House
as an Executive Agency**

I, PROFESSOR MARIE BASHIR, AC, CVO, Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, under section 65 of the *Public Service Act 1999*:


- (a) establish Old Parliament House as an Executive Agency;
- (b) allocate the name Old Parliament House to the Executive Agency;
- (c) allocate the name Director to the Head of the Executive Agency;
- (d) identify the Cabinet Secretary as the Minister responsible for the Executive Agency; and
- (e) specify that the functions of Old Parliament House be as follows:
 - (i) conserve, develop and present the Old Parliament House building and collections;
 - (ii) provide public programs and research activities related to Australia's social and parliamentary history;
 - (iii) provide a range of other services for visitors to Old Parliament House; and
 - (iv) undertake other relevant tasks as the Minister may require from time to time.

This Order will commence on 1 July 2008.
