Rows 31 and 33 (WS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, end p1.

## Baby's First Aran

Page 20
SLEEVES
Girls scalloped edging: (should read)
Row 7: Knit, Inc 1 ( Inc 5, Inc 7, Inc 8) st(s) evenly- $28(32,34,36)$ sts

Page 21 - Cable Chart center 2 stitches are purl.


## Leaf Yoke Cardigan

Page 22
(bottom of second column)
Row 26: Knit, inc $24(34,32)$ sts evenly - $153(207,249)$ sts.
(end of paragraph)
Next row (RS): P3, *k3, p3; rep from * to end - yoke meas about 4½ (51⁄4, 53/4)" $[11.5(13.5,14.5) \mathrm{cm}]$.
Dividing row (WS): Cont in K3/P3 Rib pattern as est, work $21(27,36)$ sts for Right Front, work next $30(42,48)$
sts from Right Sleeve and place the $30(42,48)$ sleeve sts just worked on a holder or scrap yarn, work $51(69,81)$ sts for Back, work next $30(42,48)$ sts for Left Sleeve and place the $30(42,48)$ sleeve sts just worked on a holder or scrap yarn, work $21(27,36)$ sts for Left Front - $93(123,153)$ sts rem for lower body.

## Flower Yoke Pullover

## Page 28

After working joining rnd there should be $140(150,166,180)$ sts total; rnd now begins at right back shoulder The next instruction should read:
With B, knit $2(5,9,11)$ rnds, dec $0(0,6,0)$ sts evenly in last rnd $-140(150,160,180)$ sts.
After completing Rnd 27 of the chart there should be $56(60,64,72)$ sts.
Next rnd: Cont with E only, knit 1 rnd, dec $0(2,2,6)$ sts evenly - $56(58,62,66)$ sts

## Ruffled Pullover

## Page 29 - Please add the line noted here in red

Joining row (RS): With RS of both ruffles facing, hold needles tog with middle ruffle in front. Using yarn attached to middle ruffle, work k2tog (1 st from each needle) across the row to join ruffles - still $46(50,56)$ sts.
Work 8 rows in St st.
Next row (WS): Purl all sts onto smaller needle. Break yarn
